MAYOR'S MINUTE

Thanks again for your participation in this year's Utah "Shake Out" mock earthquake event. It was very successful, and we are more prepared for a real emergency.

Three Mile Creek Shooting Range: Saturday, May 4th is the first day the Range will be open for the new season. The regularly-scheduled times for the Range are every Saturday and Sunday from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. The Range may only be used during these regularly-scheduled times (and during specially-scheduled events, approved by the Police Chief or Head Range Master) when Perry City-certified Range Masters are present. Day passes must be paid for at the Range; season passes must be paid for in advance at the City offices (Mon.-Thurs. 7 am to 5 pm, and Friday 9 am to 1 pm). Fees for the range are:

- Individual Day Pass - \$5
- Household Day Pass (up to 5 people living in the same residence) - \$10
- Indiv. Season Pass (Perry Resident) - \$50
- Household Season Pass (Perry Residents, up to 5 people) - \$100

- Individual Season Pass (Law Enforcement/Active Duty Military) - \$50
- Indiv. Season Pass (*Non-Res.*) - \$100
- Household Season Pass (*Non-Residents*, up to 5 people) - \$200
- Approved Youth Group Events (Scouts, Youth Council, etc.) - No Charge

Frontage Road Trails and Other Trails:

The east and west frontage roads along I-15 are designated as walking/running/biking trails. There are underpasses (under I-15) that connect or "loop" both frontage roads together at 2950 South and 3550 South. These frontage roads are accessible by traveling west on 2250 South, 2700 South, or 2950 South. Color maps of these trails, and other designated trails, are now available at the City Offices and on the City's website (www.perrycity.org).

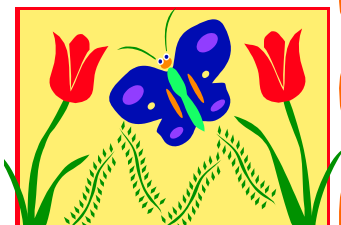

WATER CROSS CONNECTIONS ARE ILLEGAL

The secondary water has been turned on and is ready for use. Do not over-water or allow your sprinkler/hose to run unattended. A cross connection is when any source of water is interconnected with city culinary water (i.e. City drinking water interconnected with Pineview Water or other secondary water). This is illegal!! Perry City Ordinance 91-01, Utah State Code Section 19-4-112, and International Plumbing Code Section 608-6 all prohibit such a connection. Penalties are defined in Utah State Code Section 19-4-109 (Class B Misdemeanor, and penalties include from \$1000-\$5000 for each day of violation). To be voted on in the Perry City General Election on Tues., Nov. 5, 2013: Mayor and two (2) City Council Members (4 year terms for each, and all elected at large). *The Candidate Filing Period is from Mon., June 3 to Fri., June 7, 2013 (between the hours of 7am and 5pm on Mon-Thurs., and 9am to 1pm on Friday).* Declaration of Candidacy Forms or Nomination Petitions must be filed in person with the City Recorder at 3005 S. 1200 West, Perry, Utah. **This year's elections** will be held at **Three Mile Creek Elementary School**, located at **2625 S. 1050 W. in Perry**. To register to vote, pick up your registration form at the city offices, and return it by Mon., July 29th (to be eligible to vote in a Primary Election).
