Dear Cleveland Residents:

The secondary water will be turned on around April 15th. **The fee for the secondary water is \$65.00 for a 1 1/2 inch riser and \$115.00 for a 2 inch riser. Please note that the secondary water fee is included on your enclosed water bill. Your secondary water payment is due April 15th, and will be considered past due and shut off by May 15st. No further notice will be sent regarding secondary water payments or due date. All unpaid secondary water connections will be turned off by May 15th** The Service District said that the snow pack is about 80 percent. It's possible that there will be restrictions this year on the secondary water. We will send more information regarding this as soon as we get it. The Town, as always, encourages wise use of the Secondary Water System. The Town recommends watering in the early morning between 6am and 10 am and evening hours 6 pm to 10 pm. Over watering will not be permitted and will be cause for your secondary water to be turned off. Please note that all residents are included in this mailing and you may have a credit balance on your account. Thank you to all residents who prepay their utility bill and keep them current. The Town will lease water shares this year, if you have water shares to lease or have leased water in the past, please contact the Town Office to make arrangements.

All dogs were required to be licensed by March 1, 2013. All dogs must have a current rabies tag before they can be licensed. For your convenience we have scheduled a Rabies Clinic on Thursday, April 4, 2013 from 3:00 – 6:00 pm at the Cleveland Public Safety Building at 130 W. Main Cleveland, Ut. 84518. All unlicensed dogs will be subject to a late fee of \$15.00 in addition to the licensing fees, following the Rabies Clinic. Emery Animal Health can also license Cleveland resident's dog when you visit them.

A dumpster for use of Cleveland Residents only will be located west of cemetery. Access to the dumpsters is through the NW gate on 300 N (Elmo Road). Please do not access through the Cemetery. The dumpster will be delivered on Thursday, April 11 2013 and will be there for approximately 2 weeks. This is a service that City Sanitation graciously provides to the residents of Cleveland. Failure to comply with the following requirements will result in the service being discontinued. As always, **no hazardous materials are permitted, including batteries, used oil, paint or liquids.** Also please do not leave recyclable and reusable items such as used appliances, junk cars, scrap metal, etc. If you have any of these items, please call the Town Office for more information. Please do not add your trash to the dumpster if it is overflowing, (above the top of the bin) and do not leave it beside the dumpster. The Dumpster will be dumped and returned several times. Also, the burn pile will be opened for the same limited time for designated burn items, which only include the following: small limbs and branches, shrubs and yard waste. No large tree stumps, grass clippings, or contractors use is permitted. The burn pile will only be available during this two week period while the dumpsters are here. Any abuse of the dumpsters and the burn pile will result in both services being discontinued. Please follow all instructions and report any abuse you may see.

We're sure everyone is eager to get busy on their yard work. The Spring Burn Window is as follows April 13 through May 12, 2013. There is no fee for a burn permit, however all controlled burns must have a permit, even for yard waste. **You must complete the permit before you burn and return it to the Town Office. Permits are available at the Cleveland Town Office or online at clevelandtown.org.** For your safety, please follow all precautions on the burn permit. Please be informed that in the near future the State will require everyone to apply online for burn permits. We will send more information regarding this when it is available.

In conjunction with our spring cleanup, the Town Council would like to sponsor the “Annual Cleveland Clean-up Contest”. The rules are very simple. Just take a “before” picture of your project and submit it to the Town Office by mail, email or drop it off on or before April 18, 2013. Submit your name, address, and phone number with the pictures. Only residents within the Town limits are eligible to enter. Then, submit an “after” picture by September 5, 2013. Cash prizes will be awarded: \$300.00 1st place, \$200.00 2nd place, \$100.00 3rd place. Cleanup projects are encouraged, but all outside yard improvements are eligible.
