## **Pizza Box Friendship Quilt 2015 round-robin BOM** You pick the fabric and your friends pick the blocks!

## The scoop...

- This is a completely voluntary BOM, however if you sign up to do this you have to be committed for the entire time. Otherwise, those that are involved will have an incomplete quilt at the end.
- There is a one-time \$25 start-up fee.
- At the end, you will have 12 different blocks.
- Since this will be completed before the end of the year two months will require you to make 2 blocks. The idea behind this is to allow you to use these blocks to make a Christmas quilt if you want.
- All boxes will be picked up and dropped off at the store. This will allow us to keep track of the boxes for the bonus drawing at the end.
- For this to run smoothly you must pick-up and return the box on the dates listed. The next person cannot start their block if you still have their box.

### **Getting ready...**

- Register and pick up your empty Pizza Box from Quilt N Bee.
- Select the fabrics you love to put in the Pizza Box! This fabric is for the blocks only. You'll need:
  - ✓ 2 yards of a focal fabric (It's a good idea to not use a very large print)
  - ✓ 2 yards of a background fabric
  - ✓ 5-9 FQ's of coordinating fabric (you can also use yardage if you want)
- Label the focal fabric and the background fabric. ALL blocks made in this round robin must include these 2 fabrics at a minimum.
- Return the box (with your fabric in it) to Quilt N Bee before February 13, 2015.

## Now the fun begins...

- Return to Quilt N Bee to pick up your assigned Pizza Box. Now sew a quilt block (or blocks as long as they will measure 12.5" unfinished) of your choosing with the fabrics included.
  - ✓ The block size must be 12.5" unfinished
  - ✓ You can only use the fabrics in the box. Do not add additional fabrics.
  - ✓ Put the scraps in the scrap bag included with each box. The next person might need some of those smaller pieces (and especially the last person to get the box!)
- Put the completed block and remaining fabric in the box, sign the sheet on the front and return to Quilt N Bee on or before the date listed.

#### After the first block...

- Return to Quilt N Bee on the dates listed to pick-up the next box.
  - ✓ When making the additional blocks, you cannot make one that is already in the box. For example, if there is already a 9-patch in the box, you cannot make a 9-patch.
  - ✓ If you fussy cut the fabric please be conservative. Try not to cut the flower (or whatever) out of the center of the fabric. Remember that the last block made has to use whatever fabric is left in the box.
  - ✓ You are welcome to use the Accuquilt cutting system at the shop. I have several dies that will combine to make more than 72 different blocks. So stop by if you are stuck for an idea!
