PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

The secondary water system **is available** to use for those who have secondary water on their property. It is to be used for outside watering lawns, flower beds and other landscaping areas. The culinary water is to be used for inside the home only if you have secondary water.

The weather has warmed up. You no longer need to run water if you still are. As you know, this past winter there were problems with residents having water freezing due to the cold weather conditions. The Public Works Department appreciated the patience each consumer had when this happened

Business Licenses and Home Occupations

➤ Home Occupation

If you are operating a business in your home and do not have a home occupation from Roosevelt City you are not in compliance with Roosevelt City. Any type of business in which a profit is made over \$1,000/year is subject to a Home Occupation. However, the business must be in a zoning area which allows this type business.

➤ Business License

A business license is required for a business to be conducted in a commercial, industrial or manufacturing area. Zoning for the type of business is required which allows the business to be compliance with the Roosevelt City's Land Use Code.

The Land Use Code for Roosevelt City will help you determine if your type of business will be allowed in a certain area in your home or another location. To view the Land Use Code, it is located on the Roosevelt City's website,

www.rooseveltcity.com, Click on Government, then Planning and Zoning, and you will see the Land Use Code section.
