Blocks will be set in the corners and spaces in a Carpenter's Wheel block. Finished size: 80 x 80.

Buck-A-Block is a program where you come in monthly and get two strips of fabric & block instructions for \$1. Thangles are sold separately for \$5.49 per package. This year we will use 2.0" Thangles. There is no start up fee.

- We start in June.
- First block costs \$1 per month
- Additional blocks cost \$2 each per month
- Early/Late pick up fee is an extra \$1 per block
- Friend pick up fee is an extra \$1 per block

- Online & Phone enrollment is accepted with credit or debit card.
- Class fee is due at time of registration. Without payment, your name will be placed on the waiting list
- Supply list available upon payment of class fee. It can be faxed, emailed or mailed.
- Class supplies are 15% off. Please let the cashier know you are purchasing for a class.
- Please purchase your supplies prior to class day. We cannot guarantee we will have the supplies in stock on the day of class.
- If you need something PLEASE PLACE A SPECIAL ORDER. We can hold or order it for you.
- It takes 2-3 weeks for orders to ship to Alaska. Please plan accordingly.
- All cancellations must be made at least 10 days in advance. No refund or transfers will be given for late cancellations, or "no shows."
- If class registration is below our minimum of 2, we will make every effort to fill the class. If the class must be cancelled, we will notify you 5 days in advance and refund your fee
- We will give you a reminder call about your upcoming class.

Quilting Basics Sampler

This charming sampler quilt is ideal for beginner quilters. You will develop your basic quilt making skills (rotary cutting, sewing accurate ½" seams, and pressing). You'll learn how to choose fabric and piece quilt blocks using half-square triangles, quarter-square triangles and flying geese units. You'll create a quilt top that has sashing with corner stones and borders. We will wrap up with an

introduction to finishing techniques.

Using the Strip Tube Ruler (or a square-up ruler), cut out diagonally pieced half square triangle blocks. It is a fun and fast way to make an eye-catching quilt. Easy enough for the confident beginner.

It is 100% polyester so it will wash and wear forever (well almost). You almost have to feel it to believe how wonderful it is.


Hacksaw

This pattern uses one Bali Pop Pack (2 ½ inch strips) plus a Light fabric, an accent fabric and the border fabric. Or, you can choose another pack brand that contains Forty 2 1/2 inch strips. This pattern is not designed for Fat Quarters

Half-square triangles are one the most commonly used patchwork component in quilting. This fun quilt uses the sandwich method to create quick and easy half-square triangles. Raid your stash selecting two color families to make a scraptastic masterpiece.


Help With Hexagons

Paper Piece With Confidence

A sewing technique called foundation paper piecing is when you are sewing the pieces onto the foundation units or paper. Paper piecing creates quilts that can look intimidating! Yet, by following Judy Niemeyer's techniques for cutting and piecing you will find you can master any of her patterns. Curved piecing and traditional piecing are requred to join and finish the quilt after the foundation piecing is completed. There are quick cutting instructions that are designed to keep you organized. You can put it aside and when you return you can easily catch up where you left off.

Stack 'N Whack

Stack-n-Whack is an easy way to create quilt blocks with unique kaleidoscope designs. These designs require a set of identical pieces cut from a print fabric. Rather than finding and cutting each piece individually, a quilter can cut and layer a number of large, identical print rectangles to make a stack. Each triangle or wedge cut from the stack produces a set of identical pieces that will create the kaleidoscope effect for one block.
