
## SPRING CLEANUP

- Proposed staff and schedule (Note: It is requested that the enterprise be open in conjunction with the Golf Course.)
- Operating and advertising plan to work with the Golf Pro/Manager to include methods for attracting new business
- List past experience in restaurant service

### CEMETERY INFO

Now that the mowing season is upon us, we remind residents that, in consideration of the city workers, please take notice in placing artificial flowers, wires or other items on graves that might in some way interfere with the mowing of the grass.

Items left on graves can create hazards for cemetery workers and make it difficult to maintain the plots. Floral pieces or displays left on any grave shall be removed ten (10) days after original placement, except in emergency. Those displays left on the base of the headstone will not be removed. Please remember that private landscaping in the cemetery is against city ordinances.
