BARKING DOGS



With the summer heat, come open windows and a nice evening out on the deck or patio. If you have dogs, please be respectful of your neighbors and do whatever you can to keep them quiet and in your yard. Our City ordinance states that: *"No person shall own, keep, or harbor any animal which by loud, continued, or frequent barking, howling, yelping, or by noxious or offensive odors shall annoy, disturb, or endanger the health and welfare of any person or neighborhood. A violation of this subsection shall be a class c misdemeanor. Each day a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense. Such violation must be witnessed by the animal control officer, or the person making the complaint must file the complaint with the Emery County sheriff's office."*

If you spill something, pick it up, don't leave it on the ground. Please follow the rules on what can be dumped in the dumpsters and what cannot. If we all just show a little more pride, a little more respect for that small area of our town then it might spread into other areas. But we have to start somewhere. If the situation continues as is, the dumpsters will either be removed or we will have to add an additional charge to your garbage bill, it is as simple as that. So please do everyone in town a favor as well as visitors to our town and cleanup after yourself and just be respectful.

PLEASE DO NOT PUT REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS, TIRES, OILS, METALS, OLD PAINT OR TREES INTO THE DUMPSTERS. THEY **MUST** BE BROUGHT INTO THE LANDFILL FOR DISPOSAL. THERE IS A FOUR (4) TIRE LIMIT PER VISIT.

GENERAL FIREWORK RULES AND GUIDELINES

It is lawful to purchase class C fireworks from June 26th through July 26.

As of 2011, a new type of aerial firework is lawful. Aerial devices, also known as "multiple tube", "repeater", or "cake" fireworks often look like miniature professional displays and can travel high into the air, as much as 150 feet.

Still not allowed: firecrackers, M-80, cherry bombs, bottle rockets, roman candles, single reloadable mortars, and ground salutes.

You must be 16 years old to handle or light fireworks.

Fireworks need space from trees, carports, structures, or other obstacles. Aerial or "cake" fireworks need at least a 30 foot bubble of clearance around on the ground and above in the air. Some need as much as 150 feet clearance in the air.

Do not attempt to re-ignite a firework that had a misfire or did not light.

After the display, Children should not pick up fireworks that may be left over, they may still be active.

Ferron City Ordinance 2012-2

It shall only be lawful to discharge legal, Class C common fireworks within city limits between July 1 and July 7 and July 21 and July 27 between the hours of 11:00 am and 11:00 pm (and until midnight on July 4 and July 24).

It shall be unlawful for any person to sell or offer for retail sale, or to discharge or to have in their possession any fireworks in Ferron City other than class C common Utah state approved explosives used in accordance with Utah Code Ann. Sections 53-7-220 through 225, and only on the dates specified above.

It is unlawful for any person to discharge any fireworks within 20 feet of any residence, dwelling, or structure.

Any violation shall be a class B misdemeanor punishable by both fine and imprisonment as set forth in Utah Law.




