Knitting Socks on a Single Circular Needle from the Top Down



Learn how to knit a basic chunky sock from the top down using only one circular needle. You will learn how a sock is constructed, and how to measure to determine the correct sizing. Each class will focus on a particular section of the sock:

- Part 1**-The cast-on and leg of the sock.
- Part 2**-The heel flap, turning the heel, and the sock gusset.
- Part 3**- Knitting the toe and finishing the sock.

Class participants should be able to cast on, and knit and purl.

Specific techniques such as decreasing and short rows will be shown in class. **\$69**

Materials- Size 8 circular needles 32"-40" length and yarn are not included. Stitch markers, tapestry needle, measuring tape, and scissors.


