### Project Overview

**Milliken is embarking on an exciting journey and we want to hear from you!** We will be forming the vision for the downtown portion of our community, how you want our downtown to look, future uses for Town Square, landscaping for the Grain Elevator and the Heritage House/Museum. This will be a fun process to get involved and an opportunity for you to help us shape the vision of downtown Milliken. All residents have a valuable say in the future of Milliken's downtown.

Our downtown is composed of shared memories, a vital throughway of economic opportunity, and the capability of bringing people together to live, work and congregate for community-building activities. Developing Downtown Design Guidelines has the potential to bring a diverse population together to work toward a common goal. During its goal-setting and budget meetings for 2013, the Town Board decided that the future use of our Town Square should be part of a larger vision for all of Downtown Milliken. The Town Trustees received a \$25,000 grant from the State of Colorado and have retained Britina to facilitate this exciting process.
