



Police Officer Position

Milliken Police Department is seeking applicants for a current Patrol Officer vacancy.

Our department provides community-based policing for a community of 6,000 with 9 sworn officers and one civilian support personnel. Milliken is located on the Front Range of Northern Colorado, 45 minutes north of Denver.

Officers are expected to be able to work with diverse groups from different races, ethnic backgrounds, ages, disabilities, socio-economic groups and genders. They should also have the ability to speak in public, facilitate group meetings, resolve conflict and solve problems.
