Longarm Price List

Quilt Basting- \$.01/square inch

A service for the at-home quilter, basting is done in long even rows. The stitches are spaced about 3-4 inches apart and are easy to pull out when you are finished.

Edge-to-edge computerized quilting-\$.015/square inch (2-6 week wait)

All-over longarm quilting service. Remnants uses most patterns from DesignsbyVickie.com Statler E2E. An additional \$15 charge may apply for a pattern that Remnants does not already carry. Patterns currently available are highlighted in the pattern book

Simple Free-Motion Quilting-\$.015/square inch (4-8 week wait)

Stars, swirls, simple flowers, hearty leaves and other allover motifs. This is edge-to-edge freemotion quilting. Meander and loop-de-loop \$.01/square inch

Custom Border Free-Motion Quilting-\$.02/square inch (subject to availability)

This is a simple edge-to-edge design in the middle of your quilt and a motif such as flowers, swirls or simple echo feathers in the border of your quilt. Additional borders \$5 each.

*There is a \$30 minimum on all quilting services

Batting-

Warm and Natural 90"- \$10.99/yard

Warm and Natural 120"- \$15.29/yard

Hobbs Heirloom 80/20 96"- \$7.20/yard

Hobbs Heirloom 124"- \$10.99/yard

Prepping your quilt before service

- *Please allow an extra 3 inches on each side of the back for computerized service and 6 inches on each side for free-motion service
- *Please make sure quilt top is clean and free of threads and pet hair
- *Any wavy or ruffled borders will affect the quilting. Puckers or fullness pieced into the quilt top may not necessarily be able to be quilted out.
- *Selvages left on the quilt backs may tug and pull, adding a pucker or pleat to the back.
- *Bedsheets will not be able to be quilted as they create large holes in the back of the quilts where the needle pierces the fabric.
- *Please run a 1/4" stay stitch around pieced borders to prevent fraying
- *Please mark the top of the quilt top if the quilt is directional.
