Folded Corners is a method of adding a triangle to a corner by using a square of fabric. The traditional method has 4 steps:

## Make fast Half-Square Triangles:

Cut two strips, 1/2" wider than finished block. Place strips right sides together.


Align edge of Folded Corner Clipper with left side. Trim.
Rotate template and repeat.

## Trim Half-Square Triangle Blocks to size:

Leftover HST Blocks can be trimmed to size after pressing open, but it is timeconsuming:


Instead, before pressing, place bottom edge at desired size and align seam line with the FCC line. Trim dog-ear and left edge.


Press open. Much faster!

## Great for Bindings too!



Align markings of FCC with lower right corner as shown. Trim.

Rotate top piece and place wrong side up on the bottom piece.
Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam and press open.
