

Golf Equipment Mechanic

Summary of the position

- Responsible for the service, repair, and maintenance of all turf equipment, the golf cart fleet, and light building repair and maintenance. Responsibilities also include precision grinding of reels, bedknives, and blades, and performing related tasks as required for total shop management.

Essential duties and responsibilities

- Working knowledge of light and heavy construction and maintenance equipment.
- Skilled in the use of a wide variety of tools used and in the making of various types of mechanical repairs.
- Inspects, adjusts, diagnoses, services, sharpens, overhauls and repairs golf maintenance equipment.
- Maintains records of preventative maintenance, repairs made, orders and time worked.
- Ability to diagnose mechanical troubles and schedule appropriate preventative maintenance work.
- Ability to understand and follow oral and written directions.

Requirements

- Must be 18 years of age
- 1 year of specialized technical or vocational training
- 2 years experience working as a mechanic for light duty motorized equipment
- Must be familiar with golf car engines and electrical wiring
- Must be familiar with the type of engines and motors required for golf course machinery.

Salary

- Full time seasonal position, approximately 9 months/year, and may require working overtime and holidays
