

Little Tree Skirt

Wool -

black - 12" x 12"

using a dinner plate as a template (10 1/2" x 11 1/2") cut out a circle using pinking shears

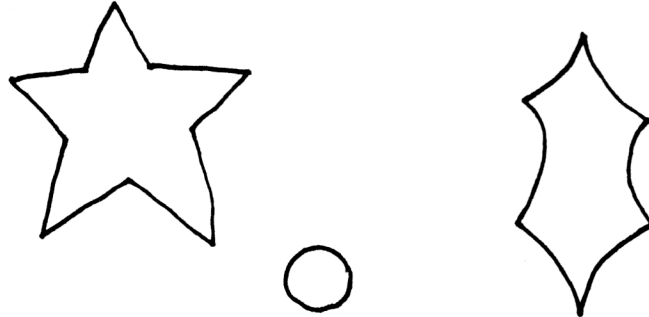
gold - 2" x 6" (cut 5 stars)

green - 4" x 6" (cut 12 holly leaves)

red - 2" x 4" (cut 18 circles)

You will also need -

pinking shears, scissors, fusible web,
thread to match the green, red and
gold wool, floss to match the gold wool.



Fold the black circle into quarters and snip off the folded point about 1/2" from the point. Unfold.
Fold the black circle in half and cut along the fold from the edge to the center whole on one side only.
Trim up the center to a circle.

Trace the patterns onto the paper side
of fusible web. Iron the web to the
wool to be used.

Cut out the pieces. Peel off the
paper and arrange the pieces
on the black wool.

Iron in place.

Whip stitch around the
pieces using matching
thread.

Make a French knot
in the center of the
red berries using
two strands and
wrapping the needle
3 times.

Use three strands of the
gold floss and make two
rows of running stitches
around the edge of the
circle.
