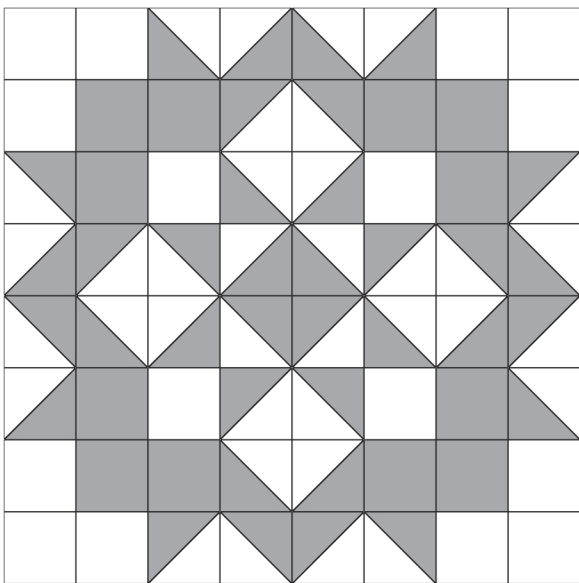


# Moda Layer Cake™ Quilt

Quilt is 72" x 72" finished.



## Fabric Requirements

### Half square triangle blocks:

1 Moda Layer Cake™ (42-10" squares)

**Background:** 2⅔ yards

**Binding:** ⅔ yard

**Backing:** 4½ yards

## Fabric cutting

### Moda Layer Cake™

Select 18 squares to make half square triangle blocks.

Select 12 squares to be used in the quilt top.

Trim the squares to 9½" x 9½".

### Background:

9-10" x width of fabric strips

From the strips, 18-10" squares and 16-9½" squares

### Binding:

8-2½" x width of fabric strips

Sew the strips end to end to make the binding.

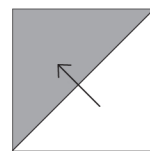
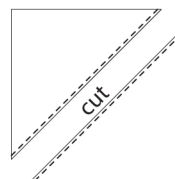
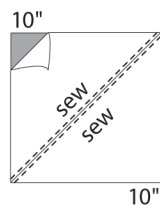

Use ¼" seams. Press in the direction of the arrows.

## 1 Half Square Triangle Blocks:

(A) Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 18-10" background squares.

(B) Layer a marked 10" background square and a 10" Layer Cake square right sides together. Sew a ¼" from both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut on the diagonal line. Press open toward the Layer Cake triangle. This makes 2 half square triangle blocks. If necessary, trim the blocks to measure 9½" x 9½". Repeat to make a total 36 half square triangle blocks.

2 Arrange and sew 36 half square triangle blocks, 12-9½" Layer Cake squares and 16-9½" background squares in 8 rows as shown. Press even row in one direction, the odd rows in the opposite direction. Join the rows. Layer, quilt and bind.
