

## REMEMBER WORKSHOP

"Remember" is the quilt Barbara Persing and Mary Hoover created for the "Quilted in Honor" program, a fundraising initiative for Operation Homefront. Many of the quilt industry leaders have come together to create a program to raise funds for this top ranking military charity. Barbara and Mary, along with 18 other designers, were asked to create a project using a specially designed fabric line (by Island Batik). As this special group of quilts travels the world they are meant to inspire and shed a light on our hardworking military. This is a great class for a great cause!

Though this is a project-specific workshop, it is really two classes in one. You will not only learn the strata technique (introduced in Barbara and Mary's book entitled *Strata Various Quilts*), but you will learn the edge-coloring applique technique as well. The Remember quilt puts both techniques together in one quilt. Both techniques are fun for beginners and experienced quilters.

On day one, students will learn the strata technique and will work to build their "stratas". On day two, students will continue to work on the their quilt top and will learn the edge-coloring applique technique as well. Also during the second day, students will be given a longarm demonstration together with directions and suggestions for finishing their quilt top.

The cost of this two-day workshop is \$110. Kits are available for purchase. A supply list will be available upon registration.


We are so happy that Victoria Findlay Wolfe will be giving a lecture and presentation at the shop this March!
