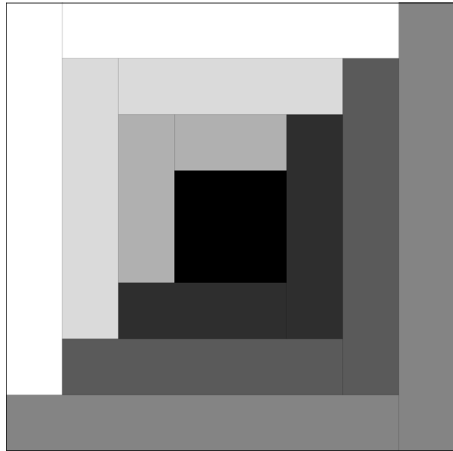

# 4 Numbers (Log Cabin)

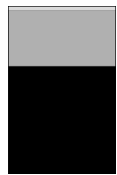


Pattern for 6" finished block — All seams are 1/4".  
 Pressing directions are indicated.

Fabric needed for one block & Cutting instructions	
Dark	1/8 yard or scrap (1) 2"x2" square
Medium 1	1/8 yard or scrap (1) 1-1/4"x2-3/4" (1) 1-1/4"x3-1/2"
Medium 2	1/8 yard or scrap (1) 1-1/4"x4-1/4" rectangle (1) 1-1/4"x5" rectangle
Medium 3	1/8 yard or scrap (1) 1-1/4"x5-3/4" rectangle (1) 1-1/4"x6-1/2" rectangle
Light 1	1/8 yard or scrap (1) 1-1/4"x2" rectangle (1) 1-1/4"x2-3/4" rectangle
Light 2	1/8 yard or scrap (1) 1-1/4"x3-1/2" rectangle (1) 1-1/4"x4-1/4" rectangle
Light 3	1/8 yard or scrap (1) 1-1/4"x5" rectangle (1) 1-1/4"x5-3/4" rectangle

## Instructions

1. Stitch a Light#1 2" rectangle to the top of the Dark 2" square. Press to the outside.



2. Stitch a Light#1 2-3/4" rectangle to the left side



of the unit. Press to the outside.

3. Stitch Medium#1 2-3/4" rectangle to the bottom of the unit. Press to the outside.

*The first census is detailed in the Book of Numbers. I chose the Log Cabin block to represent the Book of Numbers because the God spoke to Moses and asked Moses to take a census of all of the people of Israel, by household.*

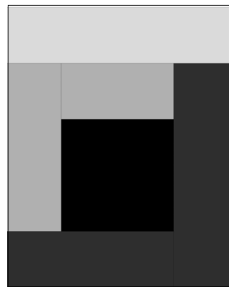

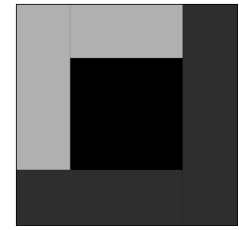
Pattern for 6" block — All seams are 1/4". Pressing directions are indicated.

## Instructions (continued)

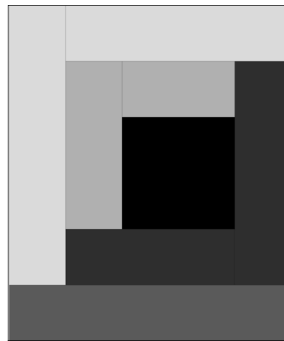
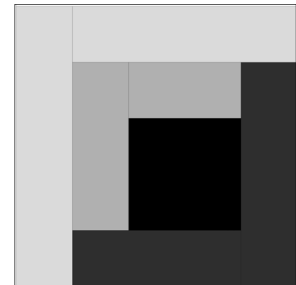
4. Stitch Medium #1 3-1/2" rectangle to the right of the unit.  
Press to the outside. →



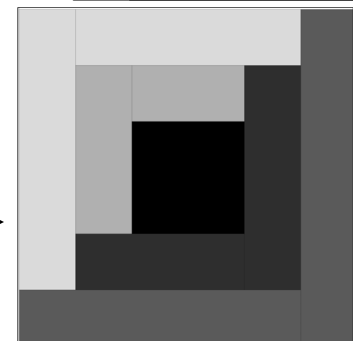
5. Stitch Light #2 3-1/2" rectangle to the top of the unit. Press to the outside. ←



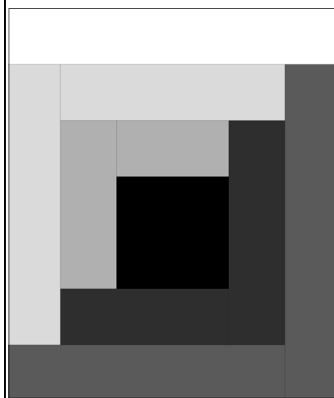
6. Stitch Light #2 4-1/4" rectangle to the left of the unit. Press to the outside. →



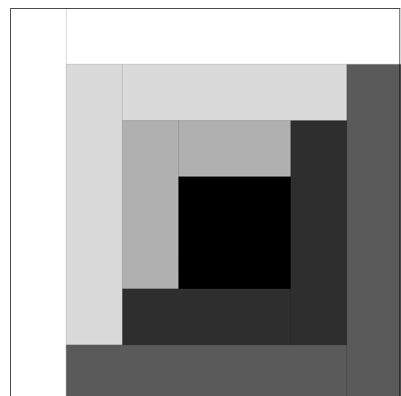
7. Stitch Medium #2 4-1/4" rectangle to the bottom of the unit. Press to the outside. ←



8. Stitch Medium #2 5" rectangle to the right of the unit. Press to the outside. →



9. Stitch a Light #3 5" rectangle to the top of the unit. Press to the outside. ←



10. Stitch a Light #3 5-3/4" rectangle to the left of the unit. Press to the outside. →

11. Stitch a Medium #3 5-3/4" rectangle to the bottom of the unit. Press to the outside. Image on next page.

12. Stitch a Medium #3 6-1/4" rectangle to the right of the unit. Press to the outside. Image on next page.

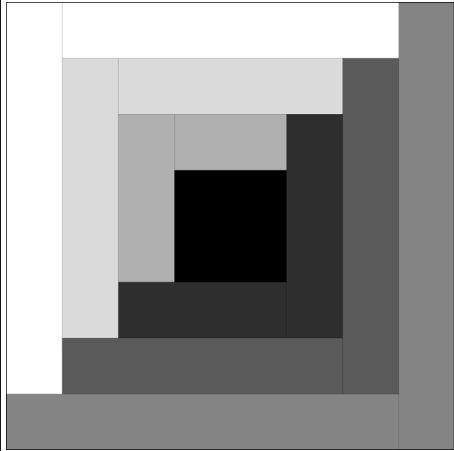

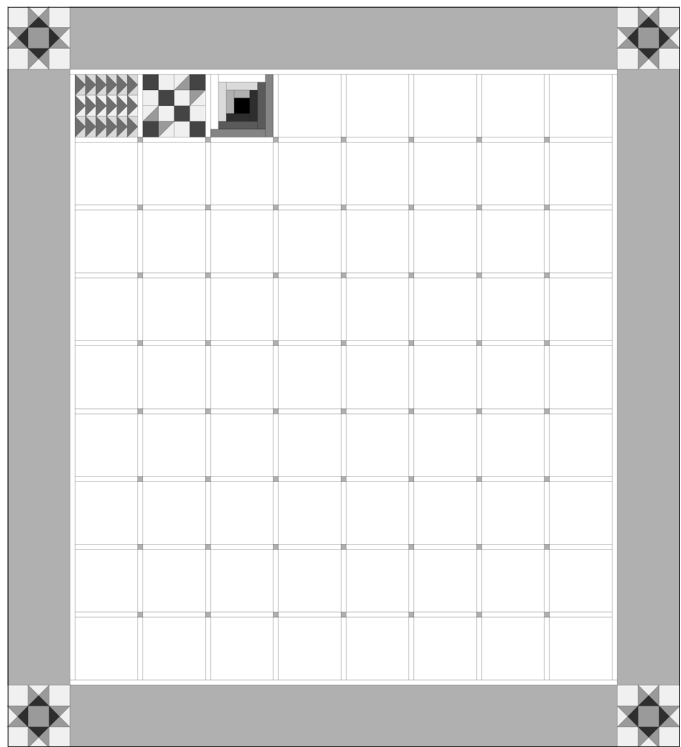
# 4 Numbers (Log Cabin)



This is Block 4 of a 73 block series representing the 39 books of the Old Testament, 7 books of the Apocrypha, and 27 books of the New Testament. I chose to name the blocks after books of the Bible as a testament to my faith. I call the finished quilt "Bible Studies." Whether Catholic or Protestant, I hope each block will have a special meaning to the quilt maker. For me, reviewing the books of the Bible recalled many of my favorite bible stories and passages. I include a bit of Bible history for each block. I have used, as a reference, the New Oxford Annotated

Bible with the Apocrypha, Revised Standard Version, 1977, an Ecumenical Study Bible.

The lap quilt shown at right is one of three possible settings for the Bible Studies blocks. In this setting, Genesis is constructed (4) times for the outer border cornerstones.



*In the Hebrew Bible, this book is called In The Wilderness, which is more fitting than Numbers, since the census-taking portion is covered in Chapter 1. The remaining chapters cover the preparation to depart Sinai, the journey to Kadesh and approaching Canaan.*
