ASG Houston Community Service Projects 2016

Purpose: A drawstring bag and pillowcase will be given as a set. Choose an Abused Women Shelter(s) in your Houston NG community as the recipient of the completed sets.

Note: Fabrics of the drawstring bag and pillowcase do not have to match or coordinate.

Drawstring Bag*

Approximate Finished Size: 14" x 12" -14"

Supplies and Equipment:

Fabric: 100% Cotton or Home Décor Fabric – 1/2 yard

Thread

For drawstring: 1" x 36" cord, 1" x 36" washable ribbon or 2"x 36" fabric for

self-made cord**
Sewing Machine
Optional: point turner

Instructions: (Use 1/2" seams)

- 1. Using home décor fabric (WOF = 52" 54"), cut 17" x 50", then cut WOF in half to make two bags (17" x 25" each). Using cotton, cut 17" x 30".
- 2. Right sides together, fold fabric in half across width, matching 17" side seams. From top, sew seam for 2", back tack seam, leave a 1" space for opening, and sew the remainder of the seam to bottom of bag.
- 3. Press seams open. On both sides of the 1" opening, using a zig-zag stitch, sew the seam allowance to main fabric.
- 4. Right sides together, sew seams at bottom of bag. Trim corners and trim seams to 1/4". Finish seam with zig-zag stitch. Press to side, if necessary.
- 5. To make casing: At top of body with right sides together, fold over 1". Press. Fold over 1" again. Press. Stitch 1/8" from folded edge for casing.
- 6. Turn bag right sides out. Use point turner at corners. Press as needed.
- 7. Using a safety pin, pull drawstring through casing. Tie together tightly at ends to secure. May use cord, washable ribbon or self-made cord** for drawstring.

**To make self-made cord for drawstring: Cut fabric 2" x 36". Fold in ends ½" toward center. Press. Fold raw edges lengthwise ½" toward center on both sides, meeting in center. Press. Fold in half again, matching folded sides (1/2" wide). Sew 1/8" along folded edge. Sew down ends to secure. Press, if needed.

ASG Houston Community Service Projects 2016

Pillowcase with band*

Approximate Finished Size: 30" x 19 1/2"

Supplies and Equipment:

Fabric: 100% Cotton, Fleece, or Flannel; band – ¼ yard, body – ¾ yard

Serger or Sewing Machine

Thread

Optional: Fray Check, point turner, tapestry needle, Wonder clips Instructions: (Use ½" seams)

1. Cut band - 9" x 40".

- 2. Wrong sides together, fold length of fabric in half with raw edges matching (4 1/2" x 40"). Press.
- 3. Cut body -27" x 40".
- 4. Right sides together, match bottom of band to top of body. Serge (or sew) band and body together. (30 1/2" x 40"). Press seam down.
- 5. Right sides together, fold in half lengthwise (30 1/2" x 20"), matching top edges and seams at band. Use clips to hold fabric together.
- 6. Right sides together, serge (or sew) along side seam for length of fabric making sure edges match.
- 7. Right sides together, serge (or sew) seam at bottom of body. (30" x 19 1/2")
- 8. If serged, use tapestry needle to weave threads at corners through serged threads to secure. Use Fray Check, if desired.
- 9. Turn pillowcase right sides out. Use point turner at corners, if desired. Press

Pillowcase without band*

Approximate Finished Size: 30" x 19 1/2"

Supplies and Equipment:

Fabric: 100% Cotton, Fleece, or Flannel - 1 yard

Sewing Machine

Thread

Optional: point turner, Serger, Wonder Clips, tapestry needle, Fray Check Instructions: (Use ½" seams)

- 1. Cut body -32" x 40".
- 2. To make hem: At top of body with wrong sides together, fold edge over ½". Press. Fold over again 1". Press. Stitch 1/8" from turned edge for hem.
- 3. Right sides together, fold in half across WOF (30 1/2" x 20"), matching top and bottom edges. Use clips or pins to hold fabric together.
- 4. Right sides together, sew along side seams for length of fabric making sure edges match. Overlock seams, if desired. Press seams open or to one side.
- 5. Right sides together, sew seam at bottom of body. (30" x 19 1/2") Overlock seams together, if desired.
 - (If seams are serged, use tapestry needle to weave threads at corners through serged threads to secure. Use Fray Check, if desired.)
- 6. Turn pillowcase right sides out. Use point turner at corners, if desired. Press.

If desired, width of fabric (WOF) without selvage may be used as width measurement.
