Handy Hints

- Before machine-quilting a pattern, practice drawing it on a dry-erase board a few times first to develop muscle memory.
- To keep elastic from rolling—particularly in waistbands—stitch in the ditch of the

side seams on top of the elastic.



• Replace sewing machine needles after 8-10 hours of stitching. This will help stitch quality and prevent damage to your fabric.

Newsletter Countdown

About a year ago, we changed the content and style of our newsletter and we've been very gratified by your kind responses to the changes. We plan to continue producing this style of newsletter and we pledge our commitment to maintain and increase our high standards.

One thing will be changing, though, and that's our mode of distribution. We're among the very last sewing/quilting shops in the nation

that have continued to distribute a newsletter by mail. And the time has come for us to update this practice by going digital.

As you know, many quilt shops in our area have recently ceased to exist and that's a great loss for all of us! We, of course, plan to remain in a position to serve your sewing and quilting needs (as well as your vacuum and appliance

needs); and that requires that we vigilantly keep our expenses in balance. We certainly don't want to diminish our expert service to you! So we've been looking elsewhere; and we found that our newsletter distribution cost

6-for-10 Rewards

Our new Customer Rewards program came into being in February, and the response has been amazing both for our customers and for those of us at Steves! With the old plastic key-tag program, you received not quite \$15 after spending \$300, and that's only if you remembered to bring in your key tag when you made your purchases. With this new 6-for-10 program you keep your card here in our card catalogue. And if, for example, your 6 entries add up to \$700,

If you haven't jumped on the bandwagon yet, come on in and start your first card. Each time you come in, retrieve your card and have your sales representative enter the total for your purchases of that day. Then you simply re-file your card. 




