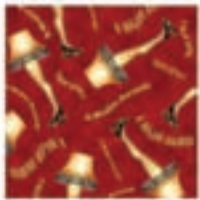

Cutting Directions:

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (perpendicular to selvages) unless noted otherwise.

WOF = Width of fabric from selvage to selvage.

A. 23910 Z: Leg Lamp Panel

- Fussy cut a $20 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $38 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip, centered on the Leg Lamp.

B. 23914 S: Gold Plaid

- Cut one $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into two $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $20 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut two $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $38 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

C. 23915 F: Green Tonal

- Cut one $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Cut five $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

D. 23911 R: Red Leg Lamp Toss

- Cut two $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $34 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- Cut three $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, with diagonal seams, and cut two $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $42 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Backing (Your Choice)

- Cut one 42" x 60" strip for the back.

A Christmas Story

Block Assembly:

1. Sew one 2 ½” Fabric C square to each end of one 2 ½” x 20 ½” Fabric B strip to make one CB strip (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second CB strip.

2. Sew one 2 ½” x 38 ½” Fabric B strip to each side of the 20 ½” x 38 ½” Fabric A panel. Sew one CB strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the center block (Fig. 2).

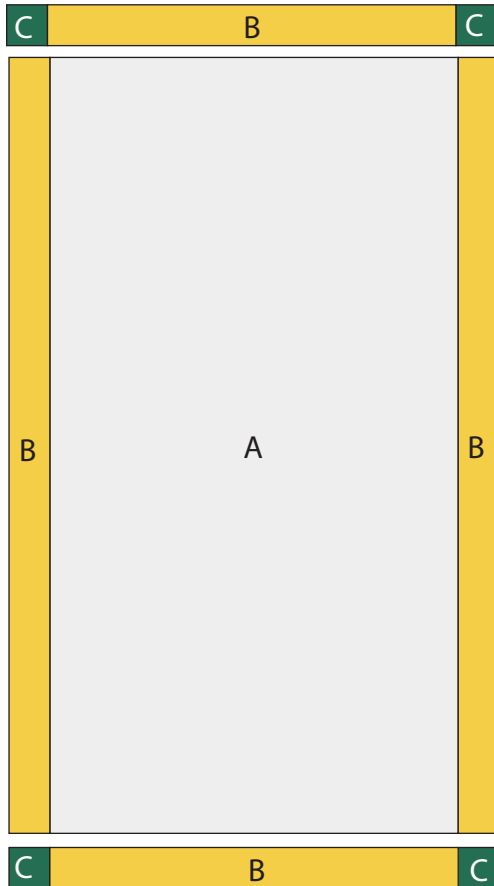

Quilt Assembly:

3. Sew one 5 ½” x 42 ½” Fabric D strip to each side of the center block. Sew one 5 ½” x 34 ½” Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block to make the quilt top (Fig. 3).

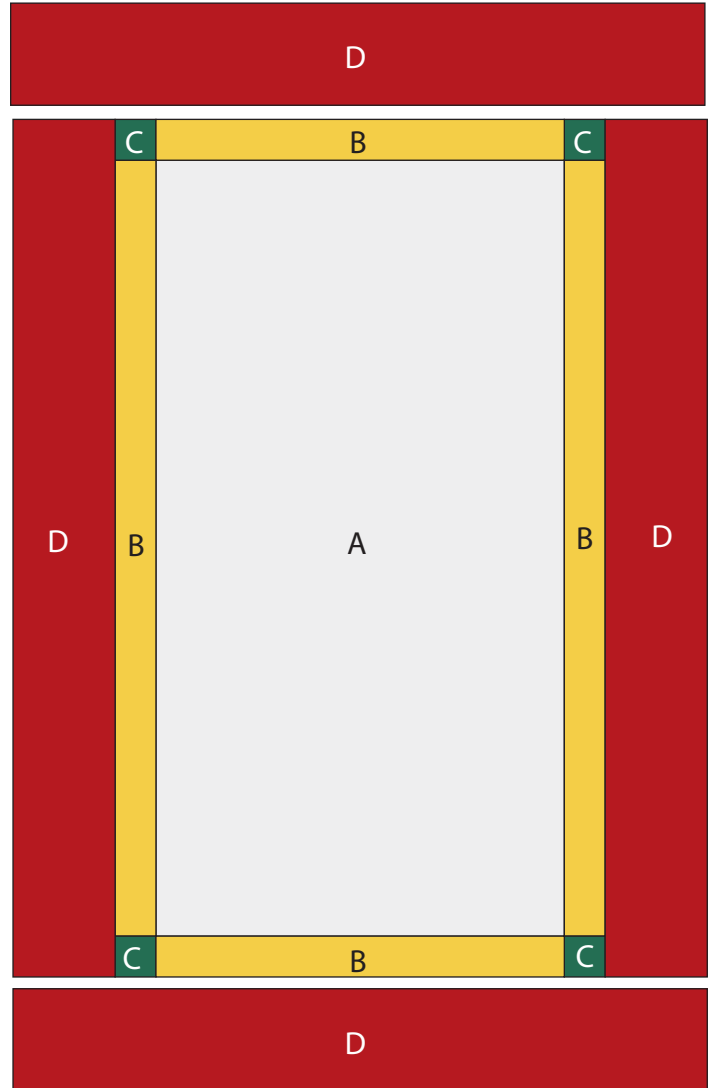

Finishing:

4. Layer and quilt as desired.
5. Sew the five 2 ½ x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
6. Bind as desired.
