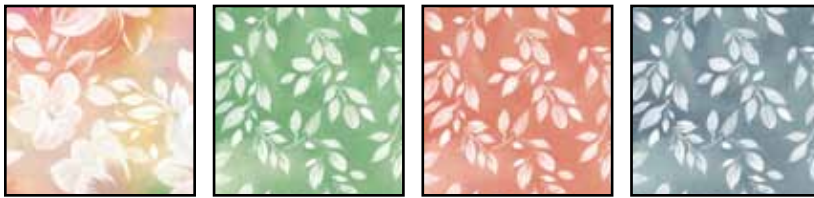
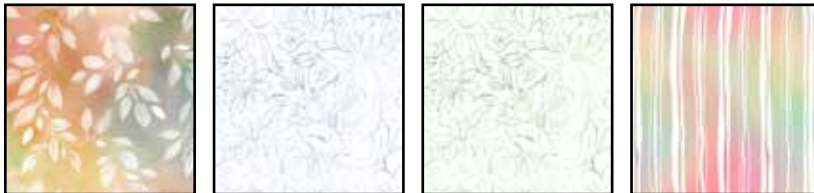




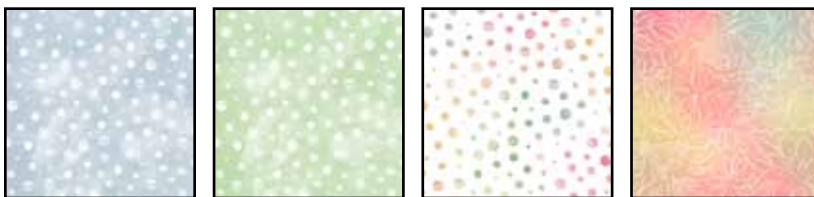

### Cutting Directions:

**WOF** = width of fabric from selvage to selvage. Remove as little fabric as possible when squaring strip ends.

#### 24021 X - Multicolor Floral

- Cut (5) 9" x **WOF** strips; recut into (20) 9" squares.

#### 24022 G - Dark Green Leaf

- Cut (7) 3½" x **WOF** strips; recut into (80) 3½" squares.
- Cut (9) 1½" x **WOF** strips for dimensional flange border.
- Cut (11) 2¼" x **WOF** strips for binding.

#### 24022 O - Coral Leaf

- Cut (3) 7¼" x **WOF** strips; recut into (13) 7¼" squares, then cut twice diagonally to make 52 triangles. Set aside 2 triangles for another use.

#### 24022 W - Dark Blue Leaf

- Cut (3) 7¼" x **WOF** strips; recut into (12) 7¼" squares, then cut twice diagonally to make 48 triangles.

#### 24022 X - Multicolor Leaf

- Cut (4) 2⅝" x **WOF** strips.

#### 24023 B - Light Blue Toile

- Cut (3) 2⅝" x **WOF** strips.
- Cut (3) 4¾" x **WOF** strips; recut into (48) 2⅝" x 4 ¾" rectangles.

#### 24023 H - Light Green Toile

- Cut (8) 3⅞" x **WOF** strips; recut into (80) 3⅞" squares, then cut in half diagonally to make 160 triangles.
- Cut (5) 6½" x **WOF** strips; recut into (30) 6½" squares.
- Cut (9) 3" x **WOF** strips for first border.

## 24024 X - Multicolor Stripe

- Cut (10) 3½" x **WOF** strips for second border.

## 24025 B - Medium Blue Dot

- Cut (3) 2⅝" x **WOF** strips.

## 24025 H - Medium Green Dot

- Cut (10) 3⅞" x **WOF** strips; recut into (98) 3⅞" squares, then cut in half diagonally to make 196 triangles.

## 24025 Z - Multicolor Dot

- Cut (4) 2⅝" x **WOF** strips.
- Cut (4) 4¾" x **WOF** strips; recut into (50) 2⅝" x 4¾" rectangles.
- Cut (10) 3" x **WOF** strips for third border.

## 24023 X - Multicolor Print (45" Backing)

- Cut (3) 102" x **WOF** pieces.

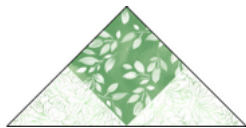
## 22895 Z - White Tonal (108" Backing)

- Cut (1) 102" x 120" backing piece.

## Diagonal Square Blocks

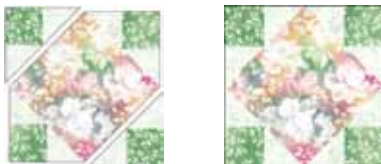
**Note:** Use a ¼" seam allowance for all stitching.

1. Sew a light green toile 3⅞" triangle to 2 adjacent sides of a 3½" dark green leaf square to make a corner triangle. Press seams toward the triangles. Repeat to make 80 corner triangles total.

2. Center and stitch a corner triangle to opposite sides of a 9" multicolor floral square. Press seams toward the square. Repeat on the 2 remaining sides of the square to complete (1) 12½" x 12½" Diagonal Square block. Press seams toward the square. Repeat to make 20 blocks total.

## Sashing Units

1. Sew a 2⅝" x **WOF** medium blue dot strip lengthwise together with a 2⅝" x **WOF** light blue toile strip to make a strip set. Press seam toward the medium blue strip. Repeat to make 3 strip sets total. Crosscut the strip sets into (48) 2⅝" blue segments.

2. Repeat step 1 with 2⅝" x **WOF** multicolor leaf strips and 2⅝" x **WOF** multicolor dot strips to make 4 strip sets and crosscut (50) 2⅝" multicolor segments.

3. Stitch a 2⅝" x 4¾" light blue toile rectangle to 1 edge of each blue segment to complete (48) 4¾" x 4¾" blue units. Press seams toward the rectangle. Repeat with the multicolor segments and 2⅝" x 4¾" multicolor dot rectangles to make (50) 4¾" x 4¾" multicolor units.

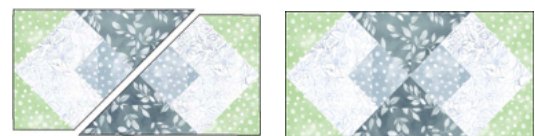


**Blue Unit  
Make 48**



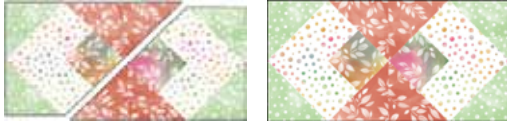
**Multicolor

4. Sew a medium green dot 3⅞" triangle to the 2 adjacent light blue edges of 2 blue units. Press seams toward the triangles. Add a dark blue leaf 7¼" triangle to 1 remaining edge of each unit. Press seams toward the triangles. Join the 2 pieced units to complete (1) 6½" x 12½" blue sashing unit. Press seam to 1 side. Repeat to make 24 blue sashing units total.

- Repeat step 4 with the multicolor units, medium green dot triangles and coral leaf  $7\frac{1}{4}$ " triangles to make 25 coral sashing units.

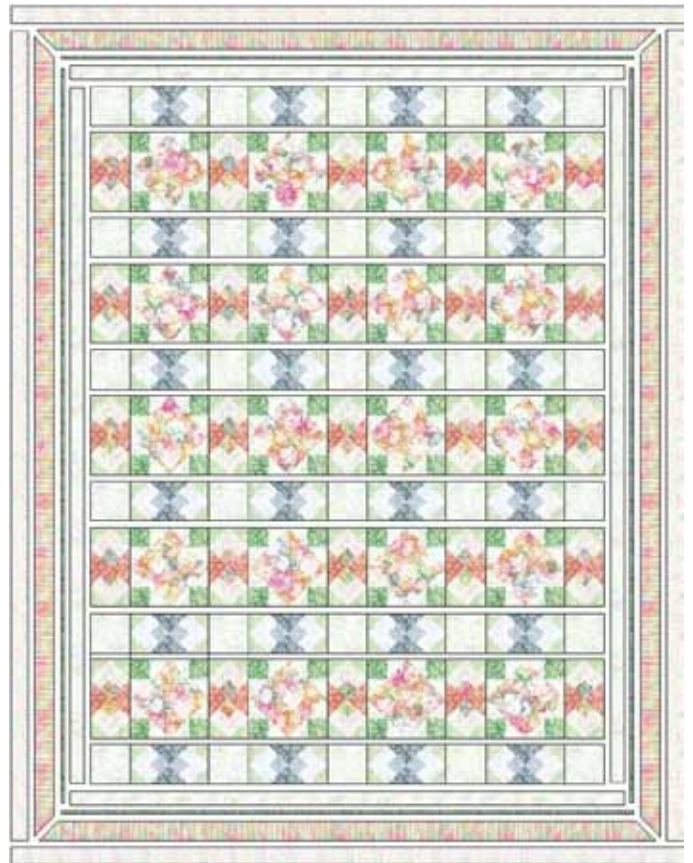


**Coral Sashing Unit — Make 25**

## Quilt Assembly

*Refer to the exploded quilt diagram as needed throughout the following steps.*

- Join 4 blue sashing units with 5 light green toile  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to make a  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $78\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing row. Press seams toward the squares. Repeat to make 6 sashing rows total.
- Join 4 Diagonal Square blocks with 5 coral sashing units to make a  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $78\frac{1}{2}$ " block row. Press seams toward the sashing units. Repeat to make 5 block rows total.
- Stitch the sashing rows and block rows alternately together to complete the  $78\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $96\frac{1}{2}$ " quilt center. Press seams to 1 side.
- Sew the 3" x **WOF** light green toile strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (2)  $96\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (2)  $83\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Stitch the longer strips to the long sides of the quilt center and the shorter strips to the top and bottom. Press seams toward the strips.
- Stitch the  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x **WOF** dark green leaf strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams open. Cut into (2)  $101\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (2)  $83\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Fold each strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Place a longer folded strip on the outer edges of the light green toile side borders with raw edges aligned and the folded edges toward the quilt center. Pin in place. Repeat with the shorter strips on the top and bottom edges. Machine-baste in place  $\frac{1}{8}$ " from the edges all around. Remove pins.
- Sew the  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x **WOF** multicolor stripe strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (2) 112" strips and (2) 94" strips. Center and sew the longer strips to the long sides of the quilt center, beginning and ending stitching  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the corners of the bordered quilt center. Repeat with the shorter strips on the top and bottom. Miter the corners using your favorite method. Trim corner seams to  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press corner seams open and border seams toward the strips, leaving the dark green folded strips flat on top of the inner border to form a decorative flange.
- Stitch the 3" x **WOF** multicolor dot strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into (2)  $107\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (2)  $94\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Sew the longer strips to the long sides of the quilt center and the shorter strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top. Press seams toward the strips.
- If using multicolor print backing fabric, remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join the pieces on the long edges with a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Press seams open. Trim the top and bottom edges to make a 102" x 120" backing piece. The seams will be side to side on the back of the quilt.
- Layer the top with the backing and a 102" x 120" batting piece. Quilt as desired. Bind using your favorite method and the dark green leaf binding strips to complete the quilt.
