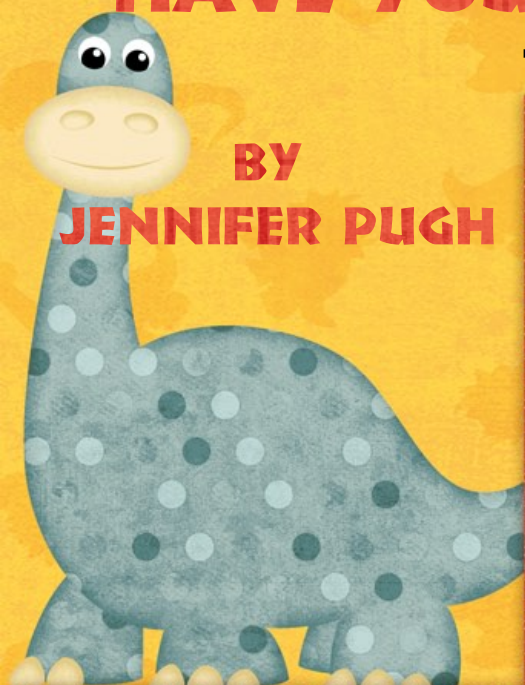

# HAVE YOU SEEN MY DINOSAUR?

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:


**Fabric A** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut 1/4" beyond edges to approximately (1) 18-1/2" x 23-1/2" and (4) 11-1/2" x 11-1/2" panels




**Fabric B** - Cut (1) 18-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 10-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips referring to the quilt image for placement of wording stripe.


**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 13-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 6-1/2" x 13-1/2" strips  
Cut (1) 12-1/2" strip, subcut (6) 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips


**Fabric D** - Cut (2) 8-1/2" strips, subcut into (4) 8-1/2" x 19-3/4" pieces

**Fabric E** - Cut (3) 8-1/2" strips, subcut into (6) 8-1/2" x 16" pieces

**Fabric F** - Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip, subcut (4) 7-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice  for 16 triangles

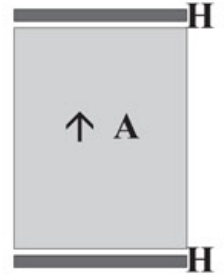
**Fabric G** - Cut (1) 9-1/4" strip, subcut (4) 9-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice  for 16 triangles  
Cut (1) 7-1/4" strip, subcut (4) 7-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice  for 16 triangles  
Cut (1) 6-7/8" strip, then subcut (2) 6-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles

**Fabric H** - Cut (1) 8-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 8-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles],  
(2) 1-3/4" x 23-1/2" strips and  
(2) 2-1/4" x 18-1/2" strips  
Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)  
Cut (3) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 46" strips  
Cut (6) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 60-1/2" and  
(2) 1-3/4" x 47" strips  
Cut (5) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (8) 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" and  
(8) 1-1/2" x 12" strips

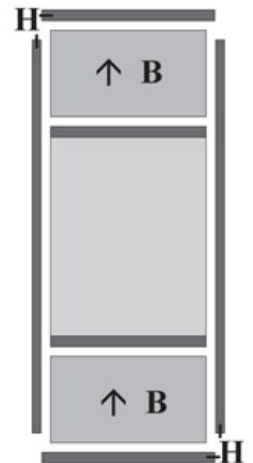
**Fabric I** - Cut (1) 9-1/4" strip, subcut (4) 9-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice  for 16 triangles

## 2. Piecing Order:

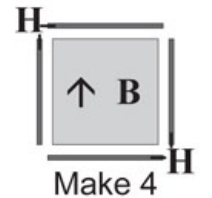
1. Stitch a 2-1/4" x 18-1/2" **Fabric H** strip to top and bottom of 18-1/2" x 23-1/2" **Fabric A** panel.  
Trim to 18-1/2" x 26".  
*Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*



2. Referring to quilt image for placement, add 10-1/2" x 18-1/2" **Fabric B** pieces above and below panel section. Sew 2" x 46" **Fabric H** strips to sides then 1-3/4" x 21-1/2" **Fabric H** strips to top and bottom. Trim Center Section to 20-1/2" x 48-1/2".



3. Stitch a 1-1/2" x 12" **Fabric H** strip to sides of an 11-1/2" **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even with panel. Add 1-1/2" x 13-1/2" **Fabric H** strip to top and bottom. Trim to 12-1/2" square. Repeat with remaining (3) 11-1/2" **Fabric A** panels.



4. Stitch **Fabrics G** and **F** 7-1/4" triangles together as shown. Make 16 triangle sets.



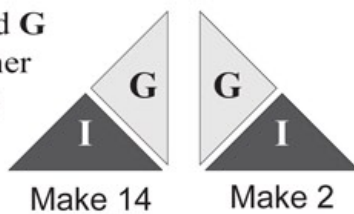
5. Stitch 2 triangle sets together. Make 6 small triangle blocks (unfinished 6-1/2" square).



6. Add a 6-7/8" **Fabric G** triangle to a triangle set. Make 4 small corner blocks (unfinished 6-1/2" square).



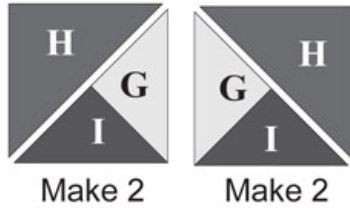
7. Stitch **Fabrics I and G** 9-1/4" triangles together as shown. Make 14 as shown and 2 in the opposite direction.



8. Stitch 2 triangle sets together. Make 6 large triangle blocks (unfinished 8-1/2" square).



9. Add an 8-7/8" **Fabric H** triangle to remaining triangle sets. Make 4 large corner blocks, 2 each configuration (unfinished 8-1/2" square).



10. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of sections and rows.

11. Arrange small framed panels in a vertical row of four. Sew together into 12-1/2" x 48-1/2" section. Stitch to Center Section.

12. Arrange 2 small triangle blocks set between (3) 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" **Fabric C** pieces. Stitch pieces together. Make 2. Sew to sides of quilt center.

13. Arrange 1 small triangle block between (2) 6-1/2" x 13-1/2" **Fabric C** pieces with 2 small corner blocks on ends. Stitch pieces together. Make 2. Add to top and bottom of quilt center.

14. Stitch 1-3/4" x 60-1/2" **Fabric H** strips to sides of quilt then 1-3/4" x 47" **Fabric H** strips to top and bottom of quilt.

15. Arrange 2 large triangle blocks set between (3) 8-1/2" x 16" **Fabric E** pieces. Stitch pieces together. Make 2. Sew to sides of quilt center.

16. Arrange 1 large triangle block between (2) 8-1/2" x 19-3/4" **Fabric D** pieces with 2 large corner blocks on ends. Stitch pieces together. Make 2. Add to top and bottom of quilt center.

17. The quilt measures approximately 63" x 79" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric J**) at least 8" larger than the top.

18. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric H**) and enjoy!!

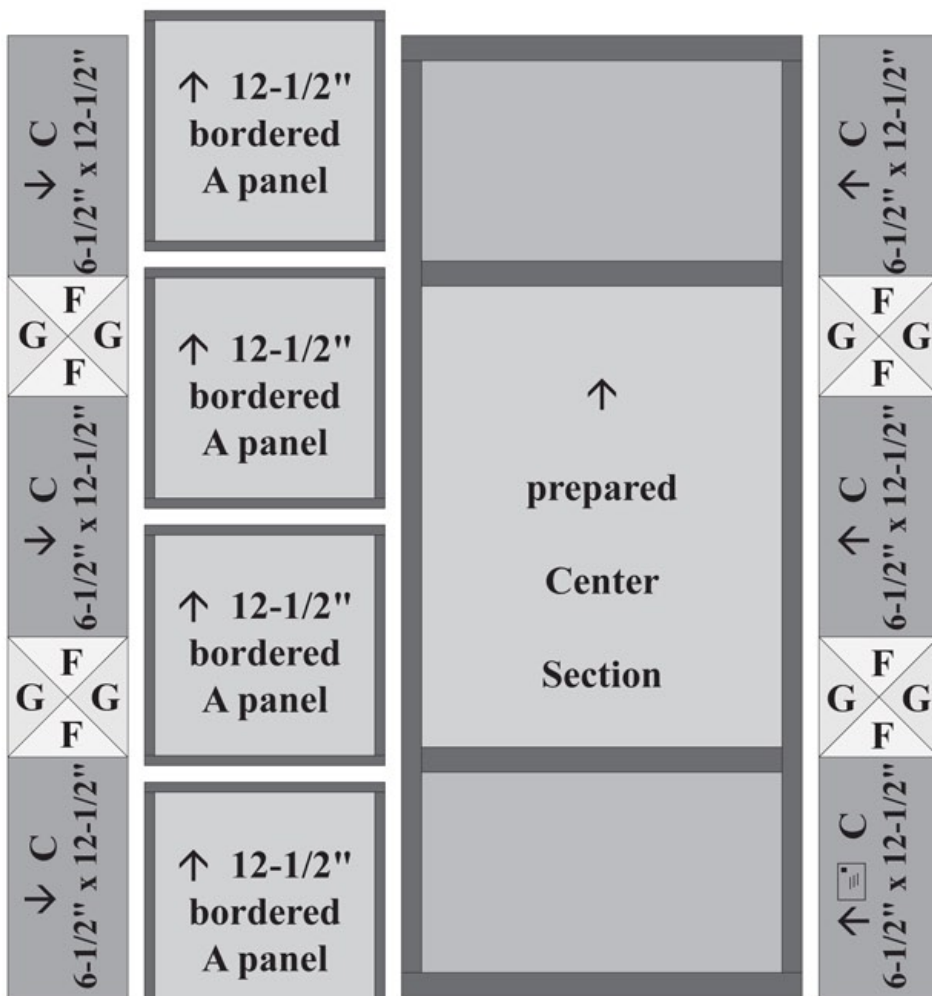
# QUILT LAYOUT

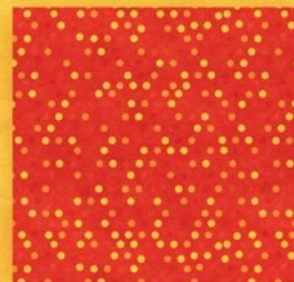

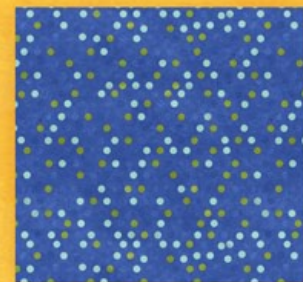
