**Time:** Races will start at 9am. Day of event registration and check in will start at 8am and be closed at 8:45am.

**Registration:** Register early or on race day. Contact Ulysses Animal Control Officer Stein for more information by calling 620-356-3500. Registration forms can be found at Grant Co. Chamber, Grant Co. Law Enforcement Center and other sponsors.

**Registration Fee:** \$15 registration fee along with a donation of dog or cat food. The food will be donated to the Ulysses Animal Shelter. Early registration can be completed at the Law Enforcement Center.

### Animal Requirements:

1. Dog must have a current and up to date rabies vaccination. Copy of vaccination must accompany registration.
2. Animals who reside in the City of Ulysses are required to have a city tag. This can be obtained at the Law Enforcement Center with proof of Rabies vaccination.
3. Dog must be on a leash and under control at all times. If an animal is felt to be a safety issue we reserve the right to ask you to take your animal home and your animal not participate in the event.
