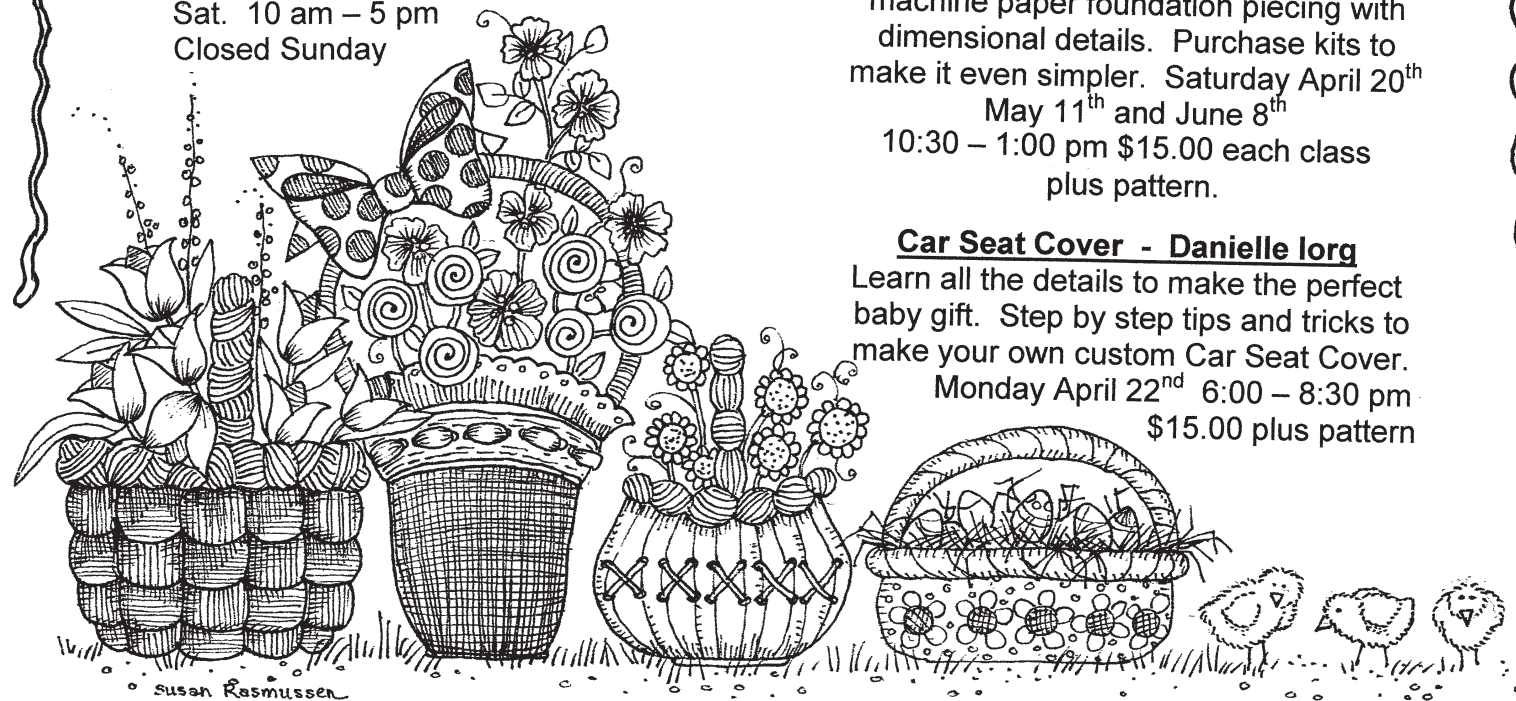

Introduction to Machine Quilting - Renae A.

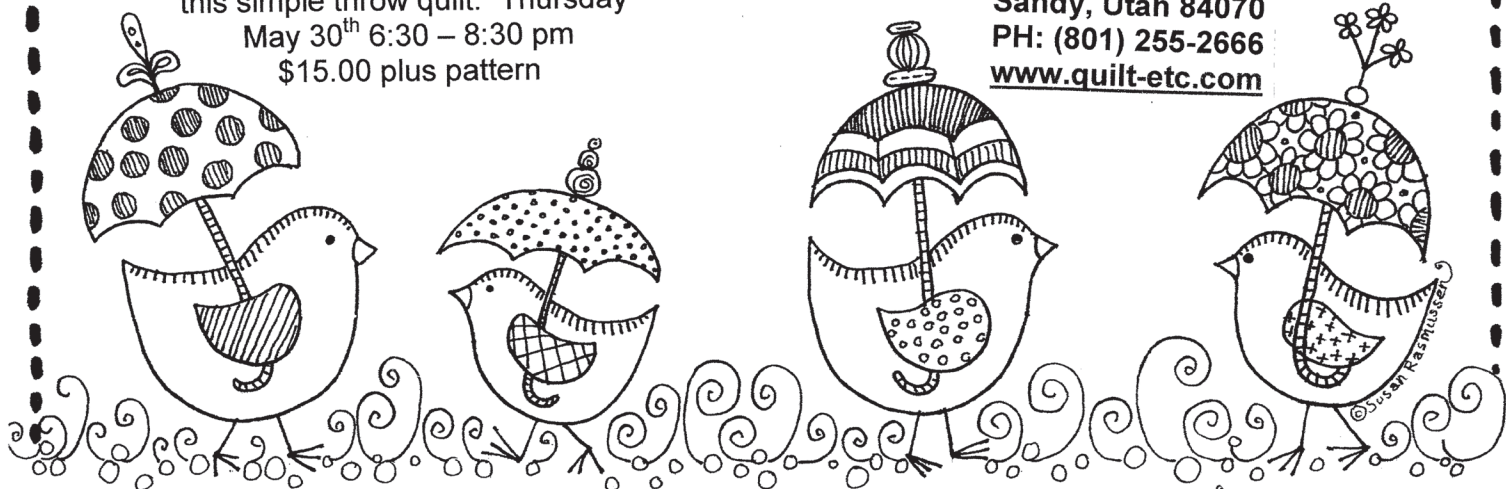
