## Moda Sampler Shuffle <br> Quilt is $591 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 68$ ".

## Fabric Requirements

30-6" blocks
132-flying geese blocks
Scrap of background
A and G-Top Border, Side and Corner Triangles
2 assorted $5 / 8$ yards (non-directional prints)
B, C, D, E, and F-Setting Squares and Side Triangles 5 assorted $1 / 2$ yards (non-directional prints)

Binding: $5 / 8$ yard
Backing: 41/4 yards

Cutting
Scrap of background: 2-1" x $31 / 2$ " rectangles
A and G-Top Border, Side and Corner Triangles
From EACH $5 / 8$ yard cut
2-6" x width of fabric strips
Sew the strips end to end. From this long strip cut $1-6^{\prime \prime} \times 60$ " top border. From the remainder of the strip, $2-6^{\prime \prime} \times 73 / 4$ " rectangles
$1-5^{1 / 4 " x}$ width of fabric strip
From the strip, cut $1-51 / 4$ square, cut in half on the diagonal to make 2 corner triangles. Cut the remainder of the strip to $47 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ tall. Use the template on page 4 to cut 4 side triangles

B, C, D, E, and F-Setting Squares and Side Triangles
$1-9$ " x width of fabric strip
From the strip, cut $2-6^{\prime \prime} \times 9$ " rectangles and $4-61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares $1-47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strip

Use the template on page 4 to cut 2 side triangles

## Binding

$7-2^{1 / 21} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
Sew end to end using a diagonal seam to make the binding.

## Construction

Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press in the direction of the arrows.

1Assemble the blocks, setting squares, side, and corner triangles in rows as shown. Note the placement of the prints. Press away from the blocks. Join the rows.


Quilt is now 43 " $\times 511 / 2$ " unfinished.

2
Join 28-flying geese blocks \& $1-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1$ " background rectangle as shown. Make 2. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.


Quilt is now $43^{\prime \prime} \times 571 / 2$ " unfinished.

3 Join 38-flying geese blocks as shown. Make 2. Sew to the quilt sides.


Quilt is now 49 " $\times 571 / 2$ " unfinished.

4Assemble the side borders as shown. Note the placement of the prints. Make 2 . Sew to the quilt sides.


Quilt is now 60 " $\times 571 / 2$ " unfinished.

5 Sew the $6 " \times 60 "$ borders to the top and bottom. Layer, quilt, and bind.


G 6" $\times 60$ "


Quilt is now 60" x 68¹/2" unfinished.


Cut the number of triangle required.
