CWP - North Shore Aqueduct -Vineyard Connector Segment

200 South American Fork to Close June 3 - August 15

200 South American Fork from south Mill Pond Road (7350 West) to approximately 7200 West will close Monday, June 3 through Thursday August 15, 2013 while crews install a 60-inch pipeline for the Central Utah Water Conservancy District. Detours will be clearly marked. The intersection of Mill Pond Road and 200 South will be open for traffic until July 8. After July 8, this intersection will be closed to all traffic. After July 8 access to areas west of 7400 North will require detouring off of Pioneer Crossing at 7800 West (300 East Lehi). Access to areas east of the closure will be from American Fork Main Street and 300 West.

Those using UTA buses from Eagle Mountain and other areas to connect with the FrontRunner station on 200 South will need to plan on additional commute time of approximately 12 minutes.

General work hours are between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Work hours could be extended if circumstances warrant.

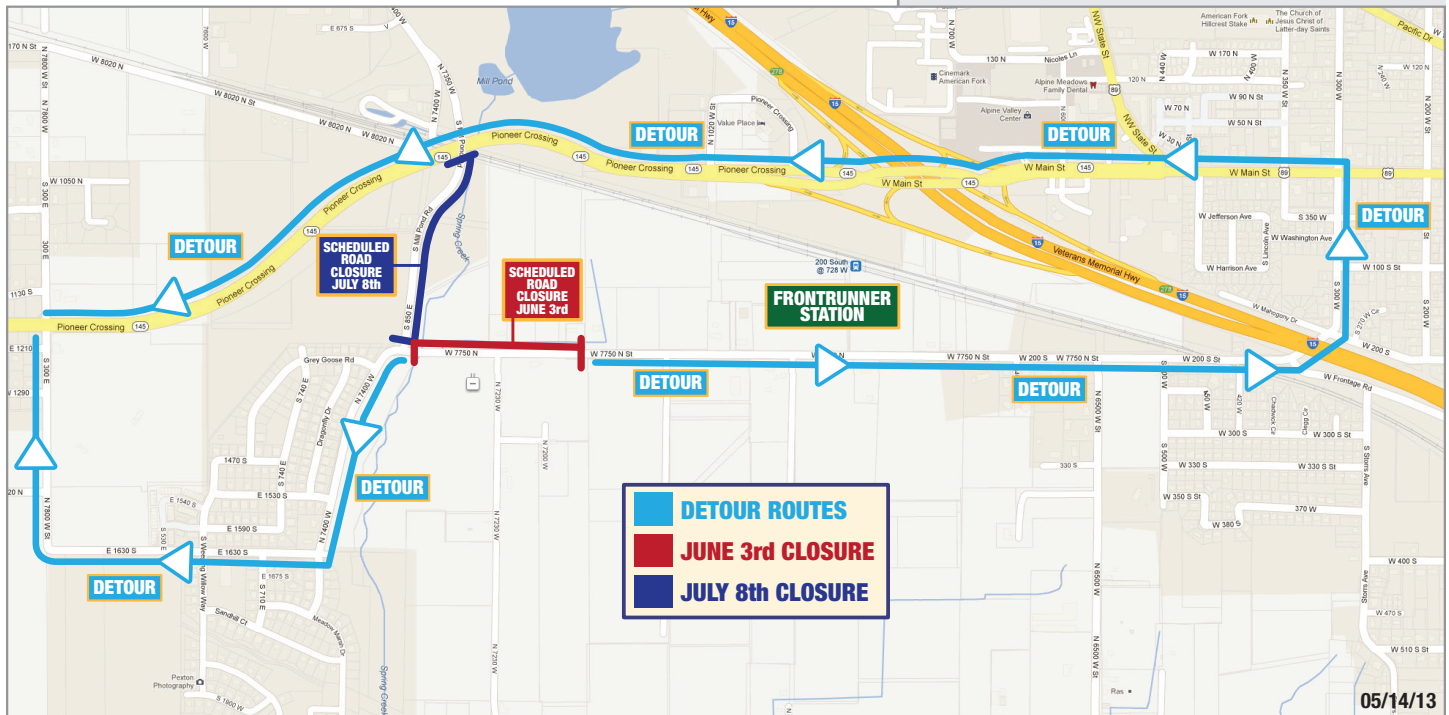

Project Overview

The North Shore Aqueduct of the Central Utah Water Conservancy District Water Development Project (CWP) will provide approximately 53,000 acre-feet of drinking water to communities located in northern Utah and southern Salt Lake counties including but not limited to Saratoga Springs, Eagle Mountain, Lehi, as well as the Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District.

The water sources are the Utah Valley Water Treatment Plant (UWTP) located at the mouth of Provo Canyon and groundwater wells in the Vineyard area.

Construction on the Vineyard Connector segment of the pipeline started in May 2012 with completion scheduled for no later than April 30, 2014.
