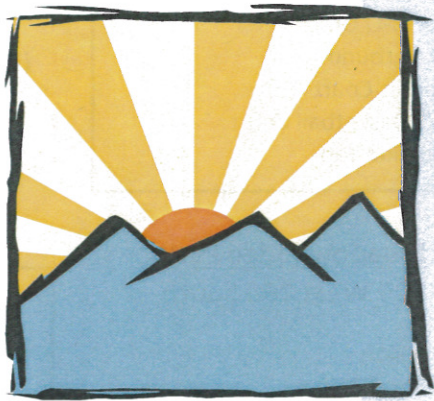

Reservations may be cancelled for a full refund of the reservation fee no later than two weeks prior to the event date.

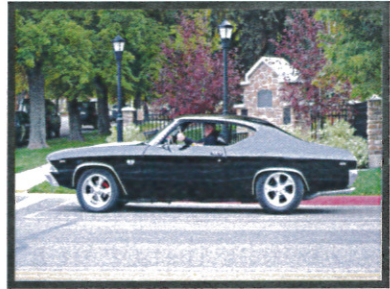
