### **First Thursday: Machine Basics**

You will gain information about needles and threads, cleaning and oiling your machine, the functions on your machine and how to use them.

### **Second Thursday: Feet and Accessories**

You will learn about the presser feet & accessories that came with your machine, how to use them, and about other presser feet that are available from Bernina.

### **Third Thursday: Computerized Machines**

You will learn some of the unique features of your computerized machine and how to use them.

### **Fourth Thursday: Embroidery Machines Only**

If your machine includes embroidery you will learn about threads, stabilizers, hooping, and how to stitch out a design.

### **Bag Ladies Class**

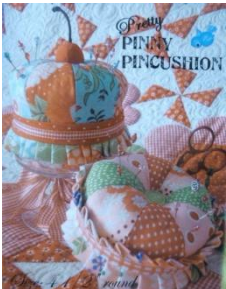

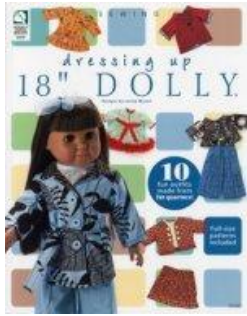
