### FRIDAY, JULY 3<sup>rd</sup>

**GRAND PARADE** - What's Independence Day without a parade? Please be sure to note the changes in this year's parade course. We will not be concluding at the Loy Blake Park as in the past years. The West Point City Parade will begin at 8:30 am at the LDS Stake Center (2300 W 550 N) move south to 300 N and west to 3650 W and conclude right before West Point Elementary at 3650 W. If you are a veteran of the US Armed Forces, allow us to honor your service by riding on a float in the parade. Just report to the LDS Stake Center at 2300 W 550 N at 7:45 am on the 4th.
