

**TITLE 8.
CITY PROPERTY.**

CHAPTER 8-600. SKATE PARK

Part 8-610. Regulations Enacted

8-611. In any skate park facility owned or operated by the Tremonton City, the use of motorized vehicles are prohibited.

8-612. Any person riding a skateboard, or using roller skates, or in-line skates in a skate park facility owned or operated by the City of Tremonton shall at all times do so, without city supervision, and skate at their own risk. The use of safety equipment including helmets, kneepads, elbow pads, and wrist guards is strongly recommended.

8-613. Any person riding a skateboard, bicycle, scooter, roller skates, in-line skates, or any similar device in any City facility shall exercise extreme caution, respecting the use of the facility by other skaters and riders, and complying with all other City Ordinances pertaining to public peace, morals, and welfare.

8-614. It is unlawful for any obstacles, including ramps, rails, or similar equipment or material not constructed as part of the skate park to be on the premises including, but not limited to, parking lots, sidewalks, grass areas, spectator areas, property owned or operated by Tremonton City, and all related amenities and facilities.

8-615. It is unlawful for any user or spectator to not report any damage or hazardous condition to Tremonton City.

8-616. It is unlawful for any person to organize events at the skate park facility without prior written approval from the Director of Parks and Recreation or his or her designee. Tremonton City reserves the right to organize, promote, sponsor, and rent the facility for special events and may preempt other scheduled events at its own discretion if necessary.

8-617. The skate park facility shall be open to the public dawn to dusk unless otherwise posted. It is unlawful for any person to skate or ride in the skate park before dawn and after dusk on any day or use the skate park when posted closed. The facility shall be open to the public dawn to dusk unless otherwise posted. The operating schedule of the facility may be curtailed at the discretion of Tremonton City for any

reason including, but not limited to, inclement weather, special events, unforeseeable circumstances, or for repairs to the skate park.

8-618. Any person who fails or refuses to comply with the provision of this section and who is injured while using the skate park facility shall be deemed negligent. These provisions are not intended to be, nor shall this be considered as an exclusive list of the acts, or failures to act, by which a state park user may be negligent.

8-619. Any person failing to comply with the above state rules and regulations is guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and subject to citation.
