

**TITLE 8.  
CITY PROPERTY.**

**CHAPTER 8-800. TREMONTON CITY  
TENNIS COURTS**

**Part 8-801. Regulations Enacted**

**8-802. Tobacco and Smoke Free Zone.** A tobacco and smoke free zone is established at all Tremontion City tennis court facilities. It shall be unlawful for alcohol, tobacco products, e-cigarettes, or drugs to be in the tobacco and smoke free zone.

**8-803. Use at Own Risk.** Tennis courts are unsupervised by Tremontion City. **USE AT YOUR OWN RISK.** All equipment within the tennis court shall be used for its intended purpose.

**8-804. Tennis Court Hours.** Tennis courts shall be open to the public seasonal between the hours of 6:00 a.m. through 10:00 p.m. with the exact days and times of operation of the tennis courts to be at the discretion of the Parks and Recreation Director. In exercising discretion of the operation of the tennis courts, the Parks and Recreation Director may consider weather, special events, unforeseeable circumstances, repairs, and other factors. To use the tennis courts during unauthorized hours is prohibited.

**8-805. No Reservations.** Tennis court play is on a first come, first served basis. Play time shall be limited to one hour when others are waiting to play. Court use priority is given to Tremontion City sponsored events.

**8-806. Appropriate Attire.** Users or spectators shall wear appropriate tennis, rubber-soled shoes on the tennis court surface.

**8-807. Climbing on Fence.** Climbing on Tennis Court fences shall be prohibited.

**8-808. No Food or Glass.** Food and glass containers shall be prohibited on the tennis courts.

**8-809. Sanitation.** All waste material and refuse of any kind shall be deposited in disposal drums provided for such purpose and no such waste or contaminating material shall be discarded otherwise on the tennis courts.

**8-810. Pets Prohibited.** Pets shall be prohibited on the tennis courts, except service animals.

**8-811. Prohibited Equipment.** In any tennis court facility owned or operated by Tremontion City, the use of motorized vehicles, skateboards, rollerblades, bicycles, scooters, etc. shall be prohibited.

**8-812. Vandalism.** It shall be unlawful for any person to commit an act of vandalism to any tennis court facility by willfully injuring, damaging, mutilating, defacing, destroying, or substantially impairing the tennis court facility.

**8-813. Reporting Hazardous Conditions.** Users or spectators shall report damage or hazardous conditions to Tremontion City. Report problems, concerns, and vandalism to the City Offices. For police and medical emergency, call 911. For non-emergency dispatch, call County Dispatch.

**8-814. Temporary Regulations.** The Parks and Recreation Director is hereby authorized to temporarily make and enforce additional rules and regulations as may be necessary for the management and operation of the tennis courts. Violation of these temporary rules and regulations shall be grounds for eviction from the tennis courts and the denial, revocation or suspension of any permit issued or privilege granted by the Parks and Recreation Department but shall not carry the force and effect of law. The Parks and Recreation Director shall forward any rule or regulation to the City Council for consideration of inclusion in the ordinance to allow for the rule or regulation to have the force and effect of law.

**8-815. Posting of Rules and Regulations.** These rules and regulations contain herein shall be posted in brief, in a conspicuous place in or on the tennis courts structures or facilities.

**8-816. Enforcement and Penalties.** The City shall prevent or forbid any activity on or use at the City tennis courts that constitutes a violation of this Ordinance. Any person or entity found guilty of engaging in unlawful activities at the tennis court or otherwise found in violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to the fine amount and severity of punishment contained in the City's Consolidated Bail Schedule, adopted by Resolution of the City Council.

**8-817. Adoption of Fine Amount and Severity of Punishment.** Any person found in violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to the fine amount and severity of punishment contained in the City's Consolidated Bail Schedule, adopted by Resolution of the City Council.(Ord. 14-22)
