On Sportsmanship: Our goal is to promote good sportsmanship and fair play for all players, coaches, spectators, officials, staff and any others involved in our programs. We need to attain this goal!

CONCERNING THE "DRAFTS"

All leagues offered by Tremonton Parks and Recreation are just that... RECREATIONAL. They are meant for fun and the development of skills, as well as the individual. When a league holds a draft, it is designed to make all teams as fair and even as possible. It is required that all participants of the league attend the "Draft." For this purpose all participants who do not attend the pre-draft workout will not be eligible for the draft selection. All registered participants will be placed on a team regardless, but only players at the pre-draft will be eligible to be selected. All others not in attendance will be assigned to a team at random. Please, when possible, have all youth who are supposed to be at a draft.....

BE THERE!

At Tremonton Parks and Recreation, quality and service are high priorities. We hope each participant who uses our services may do so in a fun, non-threatening environment. To ensure the safety and well being of our youth, as well as adults, it will be required that all youth coaches, instructors and volunteers consent to a legal background check. All checks will be done professionally by agencies outside of TPR. This is not meant to be a burden. We appreciate all who have coached in the past and hope you will continue to do so. We all know that without the help of volunteer coaches, our youth programs will not function.

Know you are appreciated and these steps are taken as precautions to protect our youth. We want the best for them and can never be too careful.

RECREATION POLICIES AND PROCEDURES:

1. Sportsmanship and respect are mandatory in all programs. Participants, coaches, spectators, etc. may be ejected at any time without prior warning if deemed necessary.
2. Due to the high amount of customers, special requests are not guaranteed. Carpooling is not a reason for a specific team.
3. Harassment of officials, umpires, scorekeepers, supervisors or staff is not tolerated. Ejections or suspensions may be imposed any time without warning.
4. The use of alcohol or tobacco while participating in a Tremonton Recreation program is not allowed.
5. In programs where there is no draft, the Recreation Director and/or staff will organize youth teams to their discretion.
6. In youth programs, players must enroll in their current grade and play in that league.
7. For adult programs, all participants must be at least 16 years old.
8. Participants are highly encouraged to have their own insurance policy.
9. All dates and times are subject to change.
10. Call the "rain-out" hotline for info after 4 p.m. to see if games are being played (257-9489)
11. All fields used for private use need to be scheduled through Tremonton City and all fees need to be paid in advance.
12. Tremonton Recreation has final authority in all situations and circumstances.

REGISTRATION AND REFUND POLICIES:

Registration periods for various programs will be established by Tremonton Parks and Recreation. To be considered registered, the following must be completed:

1. A registration form must be completely filled out and signed by a **custodial parent or legal guardian**, (when registering a youth) for each participant.
2. All fees must be paid at time of registration. Registration forms will be accepted at the Tremonton City Office (102 S. Tremont St.) from 9 a.m. - 5 p.m. Payments of cash or check only will be accepted.
3. A \$5 non-resident fee will be applied to each youth program for anyone who lives outside of Tremonton.

Late registrations: Will be accepted on a "first-come" space availability basis only.

**** A \$5 LATE FEE WILL BE ASSESSED TO EACH LATE REGISTRATION! ****

1. Tremonton Parks and Recreation will offer a full refund (except \$5) for all refunds requested while the registration period is still open.
2. After the registration period has ended, a refund of 50 percent (except \$5) will be offered.
3. After the program/event has begun, no refund will be offered. (Exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis for special circumstances.)
