Please plan on participating in the city disaster drill on Saturday, October 24, at 9 AM. This drill will focus on an earthquake that will breach the main gas line that runs through our city, causing fires and property damage in various locations. After making sure your home is still safe, check neighbors on either side of you, and report to your Group Captain. If you have time after that, go to your staging area to see how they operate, and where you are needed.

The City will also be offering CERT training on Saturday, October 17th starting at 9:00 AM, and ending at 9:00 PM. Training ends with hands on experience during the city wide disaster drill on the 24th.

CERT training will cost \$35. This includes emergency supplies, packs, training manuals, and food for the day. These supplies are yours to keep after training is over!
