A Minute With The **MAYOR**

I am thrilled to welcome our new City Council Member Gordon Cutler who was sworn in Tuesday April 16th. Gordon will serve until the end of this year. Since this is a re-election year, we will encourage him to run in the upcoming election.

Gordon brings a wealth of experience from his many years of service on the Planning Commission. He will be a great asset to the City Council.

With Gordon's new position on the Council, there is now a vacancy on the Planning Commission that will need to be filled. The Vice-Chair of the Planning Commission, Jerry Smith, will fill the position of the Chair until an appointment for the vacancy is made by the City Council. At which time the Planning Commission will elect a Chair and Vice-Chair to serve until the end of the current term.

If you are interested in serving on the Planning Commission stop by the office and pickup an application. A copy of the announcement will be mailed with your water bill. Applications are due May 6, 2013, by 5 pm. Selections for a new planning commission member will be made at the May 7th City Council meeting.

You have heard that the reservoirs storage are low this year and Weber Basin have issued water restrictions. They ask that you avoid watering lawns and gardens between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m., to fix leaks in pipes, reduce waste in sprinkler systems, and to set lawn mowers so they leave grass at least 2 inches high.

As the year proceeds they will be continually assessing the water issue and if necessary increase the restrictions.

OPEN BURNING LAWS FOR 2013

This year the Utah Air Monitoring Department has implemented some changes at the state level, which the public will be required to adhere to. The new dates for burning this year are going to be March 30th through May 30th in the spring and pending the approval of the Utah Air Monitoring Office a fall window from September 15th through October 30th may be implemented.

The definition of Understanding is:

A state of cooperative or mutually tolerant relations between people.

As a suggestion:

For communication the City Council does:

1. Information posted on City website: Calendar, events, CC agendas, minutes, council packets etc.
2. Do due diligence to make the right decisions including citizen input, looking at all aspects of the question etc.
3. Respond to citizen's questions, comments and suggestions via phone, text, email, the City webpage, and/or Uintah's Topic Page as appropriate.
4. Fulfill their duty, right, and responsibility by voting responsibly.
5. Listen to comments of the citizens public comments in City Council.
6. Be available after City Council for interaction with the public when possible.

For communication a Concerned Citizens does:

1. Examine the information available.
2. Let the Council know of your concerns; make suggestions; make comments; ask questions; during the time the Council is doing their "homework" before the council meeting when a vote will be made. This gives the council the opportunity to contemplate the input. The appropriate "communication" could take place via phone, text, email or a post on the Uintah's Topic Page.
3. Make comments during the time allotted at City Council Meeting and Public Hearings.
4. Communicate to the City Council on a regular basis what you see happening in the City; what you like, what you don't like, what you would like to see changed, and what you would like to stay the same.
5. Keep current by regularly reading the newsletter and Uintah Website.
6. Talk personally to the City Council after council meetings.
