

Alpaca 2 and Mohair Box Sweater

Gauge: 5 sts = 1 inch

Needles: 6, 7

Finished size: 46

Yarn. 6 Alpaca 2. And 5 Silk Cloud or 8
Isager Silk/Mohair

Back:

With smaller needle cast on 130 sts.

Row 1: K1, *P2, K2. Repeat until the last
stitch, P1

Work 19 more rows

Change to larger needles and work in ss
until piece measure 25.5 inches. Place
underarm markers. Continue until piece
measures 32 inches.

Begin neck shaping: starting on a right
side row, knit 46 sts, place center 38 sts
on a holder. Join another ball of yarn and
finish the row. Purl back. On the next 4
rows, bind off 3 sts at the neck edge.

Front:

Same as back until piece measures 29.5
inches.

Begin neck shaping: work to center 30
sts, place center 30 sts on a holder. Join
another ball of yarn and finish the
row. Working both sides at once, bind off
2 sts at the neck edge 2 times. Dec 1 st
at each neck edge, every other row 6
times. Continue until piece measures 33
inches.

Put the front and back shoulders together with the 3 needle bind off.

Sleeves: Pick up approx 92 sts between the markers for the underarm. Simply pick up 1 st in every row. If you forgot to put in the markers, measure down 8 inches from the shoulder seam. Working back and forth, work K2, P2 ribbing until the sleeve measures 12" or desired length. Slip the sweater on and check your sleeve length to make sure it is your desired length. Bind off.

Sew side seams of body and sleeves.

Neck:

With 16" or 24" #6 circular needle, pick up 124 sts including the sts from the holders. Work in K2, P2 ribbing for 1.5 to 2 inches. Bind off loosely.
