

AUDIO ATTENDANT

Description:

The Audio Attendant is responsible for setting up the sound system before worship, managing the sound system during worship and securing the sound system after worship.

Time Requirement:

Arrive at 9:00 am for equipment set up, in order to be prepared for musician rehearsal at 9:15. Manage the sound throughout the worship service. Stay 20-30 minutes after worship to secure equipment.

Responsibilities:

- Coordinate with musicians, worship leaders and Pastor to determine their needs before worship.
- Set up sound equipment and perform sound checks during pre-worship rehearsal.
- Manage the sound during the worship service.
- Secure sound equipment after worship.

Why is this role important?

Good sound quality greatly enhances the entire worship experience and keeps the congregation engaged.

Important Notes:

Volunteers for this role will receive special training to set up and run the sound equipment.
