

COMMUNION SERVERS

Description:

Assist in the preparation and serving of communion elements. The role of communion server will typically be filled by the ushers.

Time Requirement:

Purchase and prepare elements ahead of the service. Arrive in time to be ready for worship leaders' prayer at 9:55. Prepare the communion table. Stay 10 minutes after service to clean up.

Responsibilities:

- Purchase and bring 2 loaves of bread (one cut in half and one cut into bite sized pieces).
- Verify with church administrator that juice is available in the kitchen.
- Discuss with pastor beforehand, regarding any special instructions for set up.
- Prepare the communion table before service.
- Help serve communion elements during worship service.
- Dispose of unused communion elements and clean any serving dishes.

Why is this role important?

Communion servers have the privilege of sharing the elements with the congregation during worship and welcoming all to the communion table.

Important Notes:

Costs associated with volunteering for this role may be reimbursed by the church if they would cause financial hardship for volunteers. The role of communion server will typically be filled by the ushers. The welcome center attendant will assist with dismissing rows of worshippers for communion (front to back).
