

FELLOWSHIP

Description:

Work with another disciple to provide snacks and beverages for the congregation before and after worship service.

Time Requirement:

Purchase or prepare snacks ahead of service. Arrive in time to set up *prior to* worship leaders' prayer at 9:55. Stay 45 minutes after worship to serve snacks and clean up.

Responsibilities:

- Coordinate snack selections with the other disciple helping with Fellowship.
- Purchase or prepare appropriate food and beverage for the occasion. The church administrator will let you know what is needed.
- Please arrive in time to have snack table set up prior to 9:55, including coffee, creamer, etc.
- Please note that it takes 15 minutes to brew coffee. See detailed instructions in the kitchen.
- Coffee and snacks should be offered before and after worship. Beverages are welcome in the worship space during service.
- Restock snacks and beverages as needed during Fellowship time.
- At the end of Fellowship time clean up the snacks and beverages and any serving utensils.
- Clean up any large messes created near the Fellowship area.

Why is this role important?

Fellowship time is an important opportunity to reconnect with fellow disciples, welcome new visitors, and offer an extraordinary blessing through hospitality.

Important Notes:

Make sure that hand sanitizer is available on the fellowship table. Tablecloths, napkins, plates and bowls, basic utensils, and hand sanitizer are provided by the church. If certain items are running low let the administrator know by emailing or calling office. If you need specific items contact the administrator or make arrangements to bring them yourself. This role is not responsible for large meals. Costs associated with volunteering for this role may be reimbursed by the church if they would cause financial hardship for volunteers.
