

GUEST GREETER

Description:

Greet and assist worship attendees as they approach the building from the parking lot.

Time Requirement:

Arrive in time to be ready for worship leaders' prayer at 9:55. Remain at the door until 10 minutes past the worship start time and until there are no further attendees coming in from the parking lot.

Responsibilities:

- Wear a name tag and blue "Greeter" ribbon.
- Place door stops at inside/outside door as needed.
- Stand outside the main entrance of the worship building to be visible from the parking lot.
- Open at least one of the doors for each disciple/visitor entering the building.
- Warmly greet and shake hands with each disciple/visitor.
- Direct each visitor to the welcome center inside.
- Offer assistance to any worship attendees who might need help getting into the building (e.g. carrying items, helping with young children, or having an umbrella available if needed).
- Remain at your post until 10 minutes past the worship start time and until there are no further attendees coming in from the parking lot.

Why is this role important?

The Guest Greeter is the first point of contact for all visitors and disciples as they experience Chain of Lakes hospitality. The Guest Greeter provides a warm welcome to all and provides reassurance to visitors that they are in the right place.
