Moda Candy:

20-2½" x 2½" Light squares

20-2½" x 2½" Dark squares

Setting Squares: (¼ yard)

2-2½" x WOF strips

subcut 20-2½" x 2½" squares

Backing: 1 Fat Quarter (18" x 22")

Top Border: (Fat 8th, 9" x 22")

1-1½" x 12½" strip

Border & Binding : (½ yard)

2-2½" x WOF strips (Binding)

2-1½" x WOF strips

subcut 2-1½" x 16½" strips

1-1½" x 12½" strip

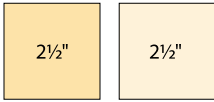

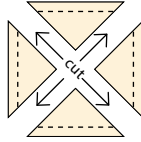
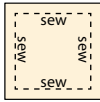

Quilt Construction

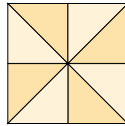
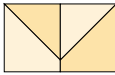
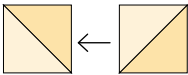
- 1 Block:** Layer (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Light and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Dark square right sides together. Sew on all four sides using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Cut twice on the diagonal. Press. Combine as shown to make one Block. Make 20 Blocks.



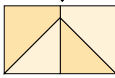
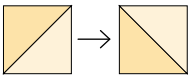
Layer right sides together.



Makes 4.

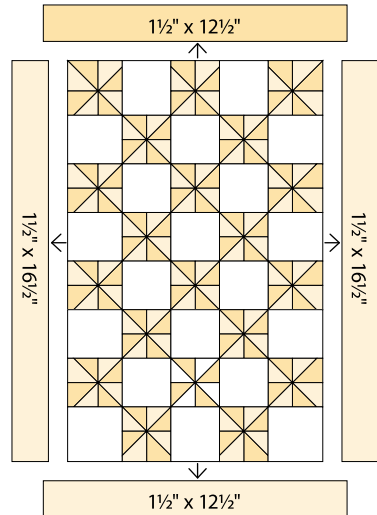
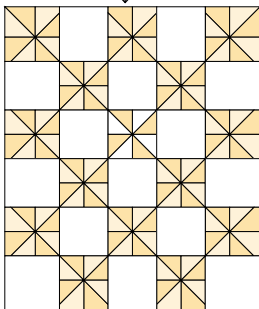
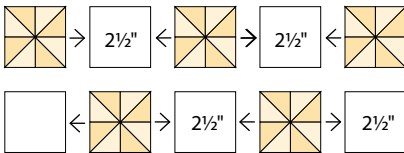


Block

- 2 Assembly:** Combine the Blocks and Setting Squares in row as shown. Combine the rows. Add the side Borders first then the top and bottom Borders.



- 3** Sew $2-2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Binding strips together. Layer, quilt and bind. ENJOY!
