## A Little Fall Rail Fence Quilt

44" x 52"



Jellyroll and Beginner Friendly Quilt!

### Supplies:

	crib, lap, twin, full
#1 – dark	( $\frac{1}{4}$ , $\frac{3}{8}$ , $\frac{5}{8}$ , $\frac{3}{4}$ ) yds
#1 – medium dark	( $\frac{1}{4}$ , $\frac{3}{8}$ , $\frac{5}{8}$ , $\frac{3}{4}$ ) yds
#1 – medium light	( $\frac{1}{4}$ , $\frac{2}{3}$ , 1, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) yds
Same light	( $\frac{1}{3}$ , $\frac{3}{8}$ , $\frac{5}{8}$ , $\frac{3}{4}$ ) yds
#2 – medium light	( $\frac{1}{4}$ , $\frac{3}{8}$ , $\frac{5}{8}$ , $\frac{3}{4}$ ) yds
#2 – medium dark	( $\frac{1}{4}$ , $\frac{3}{8}$ , $\frac{5}{8}$ , $\frac{3}{4}$ ) yds
#2 – dark	( $\frac{1}{4}$ , $\frac{3}{8}$ , $\frac{5}{8}$ , $\frac{3}{4}$ ) yd
Dark border	(1, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ , 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ , 1 $\frac{2}{3}$ ) yds
Dark binding	( $\frac{3}{8}$ , $\frac{1}{2}$ , $\frac{5}{8}$ , $\frac{2}{3}$ ) yds



## A Little Fall Rail Fence

### Fabric Requirements

	crib, lap, twin, full
#1 – dark	( $\frac{1}{4}$ , $\frac{3}{8}$ , $\frac{5}{8}$ , $\frac{3}{4}$ ) yds
#1 – medium dark	( $\frac{1}{4}$ , $\frac{3}{8}$ , $\frac{5}{8}$ , $\frac{3}{4}$ ) yds
#1 – medium light	( $\frac{1}{4}$ , $\frac{2}{3}$ , 1, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) yds
Same light	( $\frac{1}{3}$ , $\frac{3}{8}$ , $\frac{5}{8}$ , $\frac{3}{4}$ ) yds
#2 – medium light	( $\frac{1}{4}$ , $\frac{3}{8}$ , $\frac{5}{8}$ , $\frac{3}{4}$ ) yds
#2 – medium dark	( $\frac{1}{4}$ , $\frac{3}{8}$ , $\frac{5}{8}$ , $\frac{3}{4}$ ) yds
#2 – dark	( $\frac{1}{4}$ , $\frac{3}{8}$ , $\frac{5}{8}$ , $\frac{3}{4}$ ) yds
Dark border	(1, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ , 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ , 1 $\frac{2}{3}$ ) yds
Dark binding	( $\frac{3}{8}$ , $\frac{1}{2}$ , $\frac{5}{8}$ , $\frac{2}{3}$ ) yds

Quilt Sizes			
Crib	Lap	Twin	Full/Queen
44 x 52	52 x 76	68 x 92	84 x 92

Note: The numbers in the parentheses are for the different quilt sizes. Since all strips are cut 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " this quilt is jellyroll friendly!

### Cutting for Crib, Lap, Twin, Full/Queen

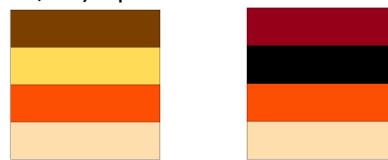
Cut (2, 4, 7, 9) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF (width of fabric) strips from each #1 & #2 dark, medium and medium light fabric.

Cut (4, 8, 14, 18) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips from your same light fabric.

- Sort strips in #1 Group from dark to light.
- Sort strips in #2 Group from dark to light.
- You should have (4, 8, 14, 18) sets with 4 fabrics in each set.
- Sew strip sets right sides together pressing toward light as each of four strips are sewn.



- Next square off strip sets at edge of selvage.
- Measure width of strip set and sub cut 5 squares from that measurement from your strip set. (Blocks should measure 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " ) (4, 8, 14, 18) sets will yield (20, 40, 70, 90) squares.



- Next lay out your blocks in (4x5) (5x8) (7x10) (9x10) rows as desired.
- Sew together blocks in a row.
- Sew rows together matching seams as you sew.

### Border

- Cut (5, 7, 8, 9) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips from the border fabric.
- Measure center width and cut 2 strips to that measurement.
- Sew top and bottom strips on. Press towards border.
- Measure center length and cut 2 strips to that measurement. (depending on the size of your quilt you will have to sew another strip to the short end of each side strip to get the correct length)
- Sew side strips on each side of quilt. Press towards border.

Quilt as desired.

### Binding

- Cut (5,7,8,9) 2 ½" strips
- Sew all these strips together (short ends) to make 1 continuous strip. Fold binding in half wrong sides together and press. Attach binding to right side of quilt (raw edges even) and machine stitch all the way around. Turn binding to back and hand stitch down.
