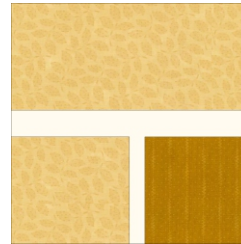

Cutting Directions for 1 Block

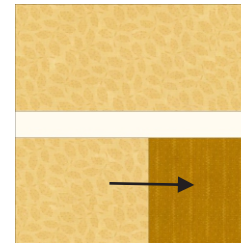
- From Background fabric cut:
 - (8) 2" x 2" Squares (A)
 - (4) 2" x 2-1/2" Rectangles (B)
 - (4) 2-1/2" x 4" Rectangles (C)
- From **each** of the Blue/Purple/Green fabrics cut:
 - (1) 2" x 4" Rectangles (D)
 - (1) 2" x 5-1/2" Rectangles (E)
- From Red fabric cut:
 - (1) 2" x 4" Rectangles (D)
 - (1) 2" x 5-1/2" Rectangles (E)
 - (2) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" (H)
 - (2) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" (I)
- From Gold fabric cut:
 - (4) 2" x 2" Squares (J)

Piecing Instructions

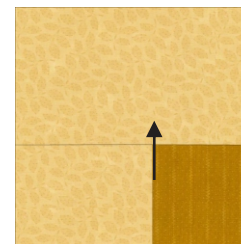
- Layout (1) Gold "J" Square, (1) Background "B" Rectangle, and (1) Background "C" Rectangle as shown.



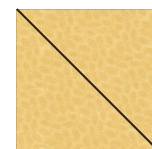
- Sew blocks into a rows. Press towards the Gold "J" Square.



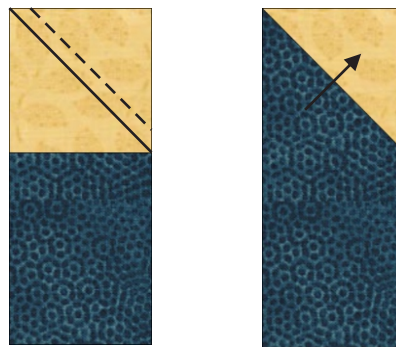
- Sew rows together. Press towards the Background "C" rectangle. Piece center square should measure 4" x 4".



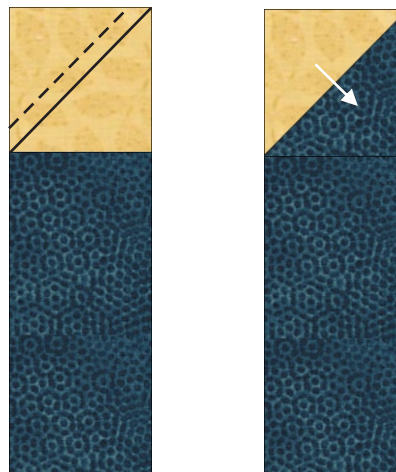
- Make a diagonal line from corner to corner as shown on the (8) Background "A" Squares.



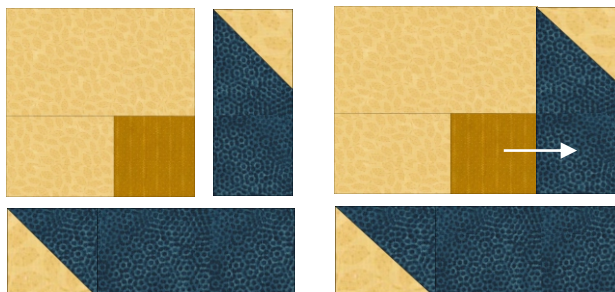
- Layer (1) Background “A” Square on top of (1) Blue “D” Rectangle as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Cut 1/4” away from the sewn line. press towards the background triangle.
Block should measure 2” x 4”



- Layer (1) Background “A” Square on top of (1) Blue “E” Rectangle as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Cut 1/4” away from the sewn line. press towards the Blue “E” Rectangle.
Block should measure 2” x 5-1/2”

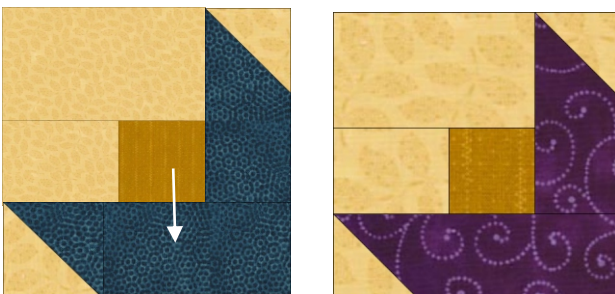


- Layout (1) pieced center square, (1) Blue “D” rectangle and (1) Blue “E” rectangle as shown.

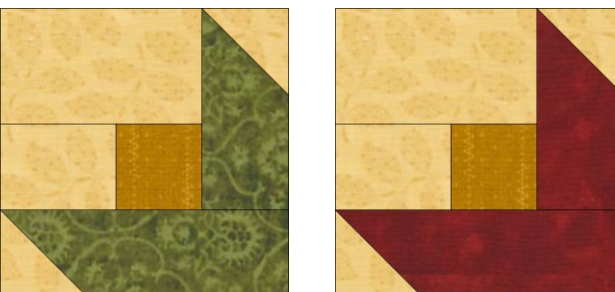


- Sew (1) Blue “D” Rectangle to the right side of the pieced center square. Press towards the Blue rectangle.

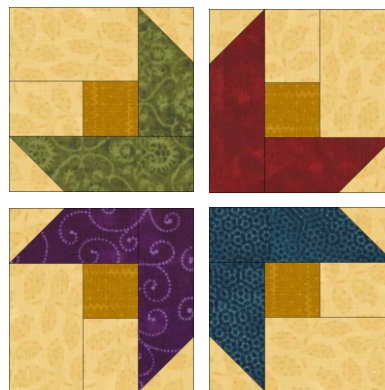
- Sew (1) Blue “E” Rectangle to the bottom of the pieced center square. Press towards the Blue rectangle.
Block should measure 5-1/2” x 5-1/2”



- Repeat previous steps to make (1) Blue Block, (1) Purple Block, (1) Green Block, and (1) Red Block.



- Layout (1) Purple Block, (1) Blue Block, (1) Green Block, & (1) Red Block as shown.



- Sew blocks together into rows, pressing seams towards the Background rectangles.



- Sew rows together to make (1) Wheel of Chance block. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. Block should measure 10-1/2" x 10-1/2"



Add Block Framing Strips

- Sew a Red "H" strip to the left and right sides of the block. Press towards the green strip.
- Sew a Red "I" strip to the top and bottom of the block. Press towards the green Strip.
- Block should measure 12-1/2" x 12-1/2"
