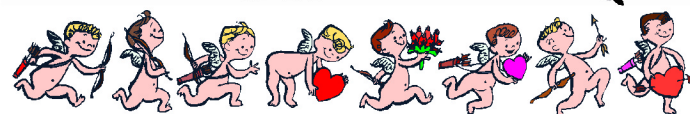

For calendar year 2012 the Library circulated 62,068 items to area residents and another 18,552 to the other libraries in the High Plains Library District. So staff handled some 160,000 items going out of the library and returning to the library. The public computers in the library were used over 9500 times for educational, personal and business uses. And some 41,000 visitors came into the Library throughout the year. And this first year of eBooks meant that many other individuals used the Library's resources from home to remotely download books to their Kindles and Nooks.

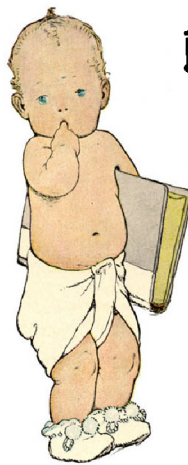

Many precious little people were given a soft and snuggly cuddle blanket and their first book in 2012. Our goal is to impart the gift of reading to many more babies in 2013!

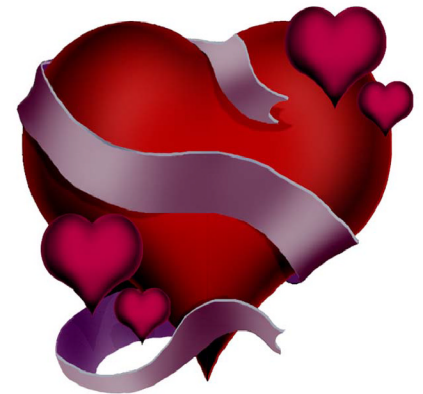


The Friends' Bookshelf
