## New Releases

### New Books

*Breaking Point* by C.J. Box goes public in mid-March. This will be the 13th in the Joe Pickett series. Here is a teaser: Little did Joe know that when he talked to Lyle that day, the man was about to disappear. He was heading into the mountains to hunt, he said, but instead he was running. Two EPA employees had just been murdered, and all signs pointed to Lyle as the killer.

*Until the End of Time* by Danielle Steele. Two couples, four decades apart. One believes that if lovers die, they find each other again in another life. Or perhaps they wind up as stars side by side in the sky, together forever. Who knows how it really ends? Bestselling author Steele breaks new ground in her career with the poignant story of two parallel destinies, and the kind of love that will be everlasting.

*Insane City* by Dave Barry. A dark comic masterpiece--the first solo adult novel in more than a decade from the Pulitzer Prize winner and "New York Times" bestselling author. By the end, amid gunfire, high-speed chases, and mayhem of the most unimaginable sort, violent men will fall, heroes will rise, and many lives will change.

### New Audiobooks

*Guilt* by Jonathan Kellerman.

A backyard renovation reveals an infant's body, buried 60 years ago. LAPD detective Milo Sturgis, assisted by psychologist Alex Delaware, backtracks into the past to attempt to solve the case, eventually entering the sheltered world of high-echelon celebrity privilege. They are about to encounter a fanatically deranged mind of monstrous cunning. 28th in the popular series.

*Private Berlin* by James Patterson.

In Berlin, security firm Private's agent Chris Schneider has disappeared. The Private team retraces his footsteps to the cases he was investigating before his disappearance: a billionaire suspected of cheating on his wife, a world-famous soccer player accused of throwing games, and the owner of a seedy nightclub. They're all suspects. And someone is lying. Fifth in the series.

*A Week in Winter* by Maeve Binchy.

Chicky decides to take an old decaying mansion, Stone House, and turn it into a restful place for a holiday by the sea. The town thinks she is crazy. She is helped by Rigger (a bad boy turned good who is handy around the place) and her niece Orla (a whiz at business). Finally, the odd group of guests arrives, to share their stories and their dreams.

*Dork Diaries 5* by Rachel Renee Russell.

Nikki Maxwell joins the school newspaper staff – and ends up as the advice columnist! When Miss Know-It-All's inbox is overflowing with pleas for guidance, she feels in need of some help herself. Fifth in the series.

*The Paperboy* by Pete Dexter.

Two Florida brothers, sons of a newspaper publisher, reinvestigate the case of a man condemned to death for killing a local sheriff, with devastating results. The new movie stars Matthew McConaughey and Nicole Kidman.
