

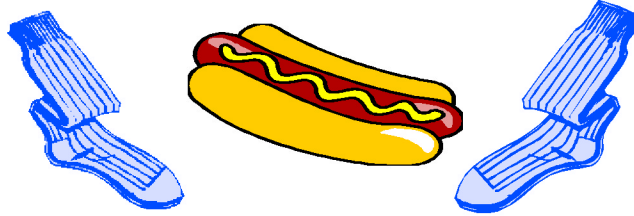

November 1 at 2:00 PM

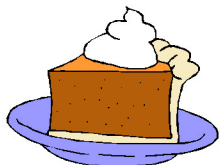
