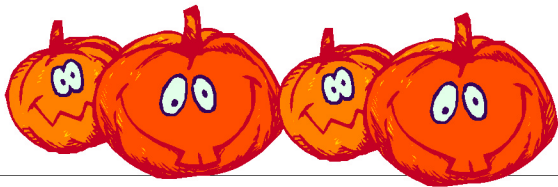

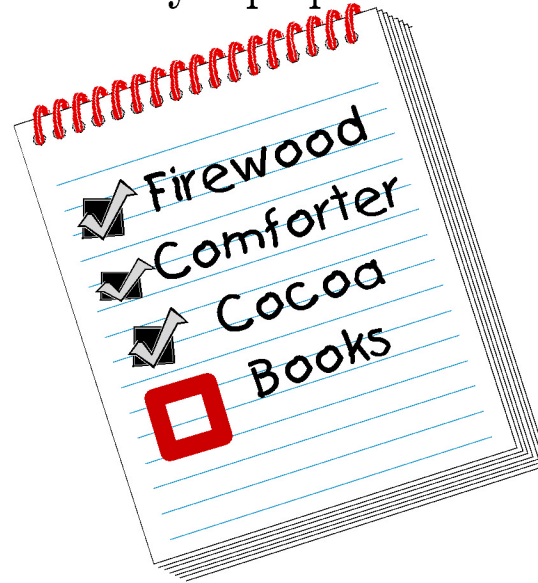

Food For Fines

The Eaton Public Library will join many other libraries in the High Plains Library District to accept canned food as payment for existing fines and fees. One dollar in fines or fees will be waived for every canned good received. A donation box will also be placed in the library for contributions. This program will run from October 8 through October 20 with the Weld Food Bank receiving the donations.



Disc Repair Unit

Patron Conduct Policy

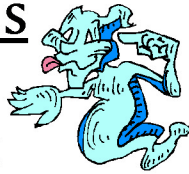
Did you know the library has a code of conduct policy? It is posted in the library. Next time you are at the library, please take a minute to read it.
