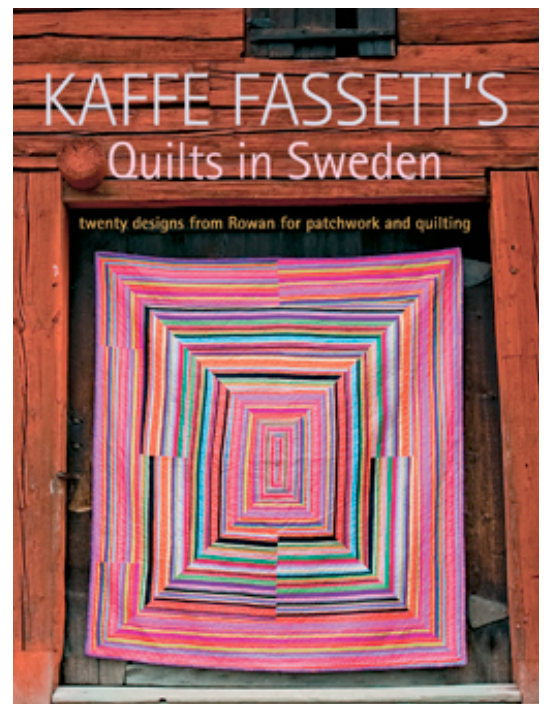
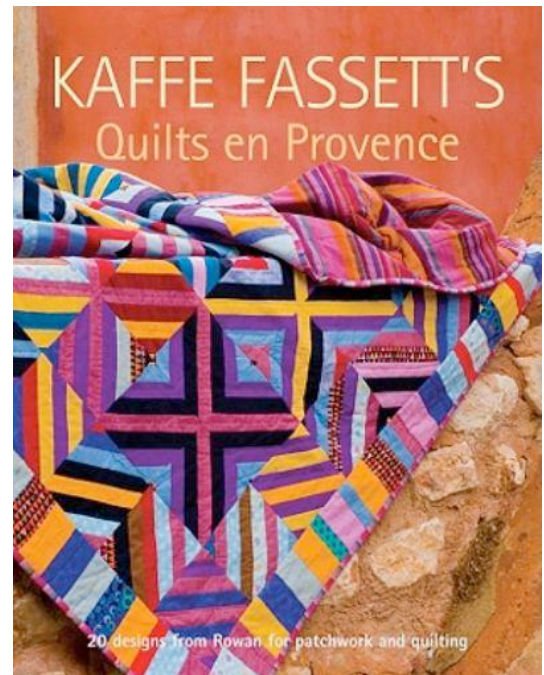
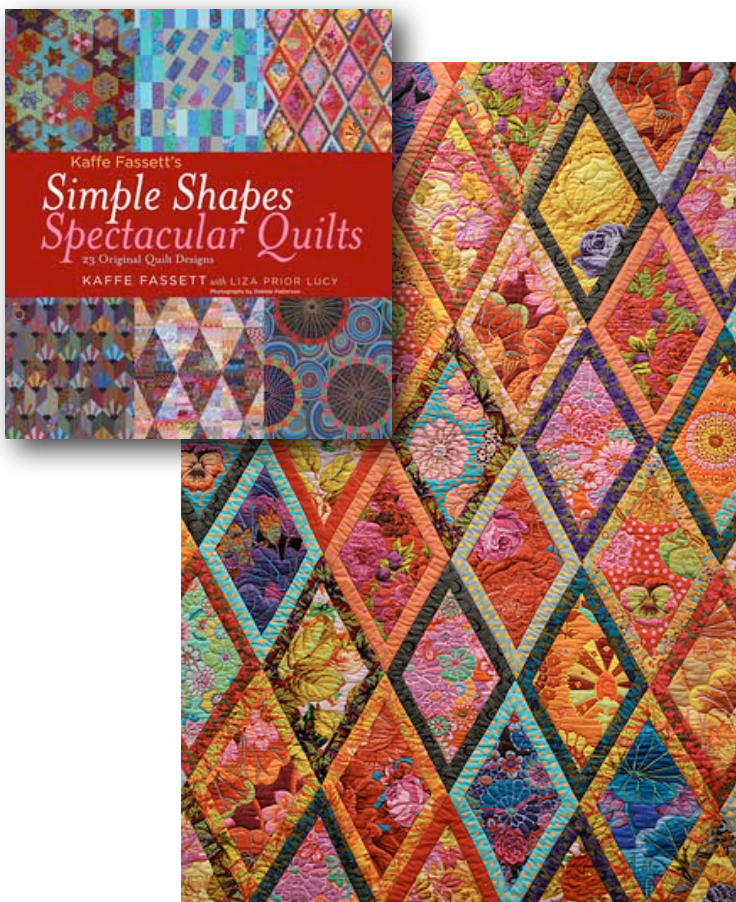

You'll love this time with Judy and if you wish, Judy will teach Machine Quilting Plain or Fancy during the retreat time.



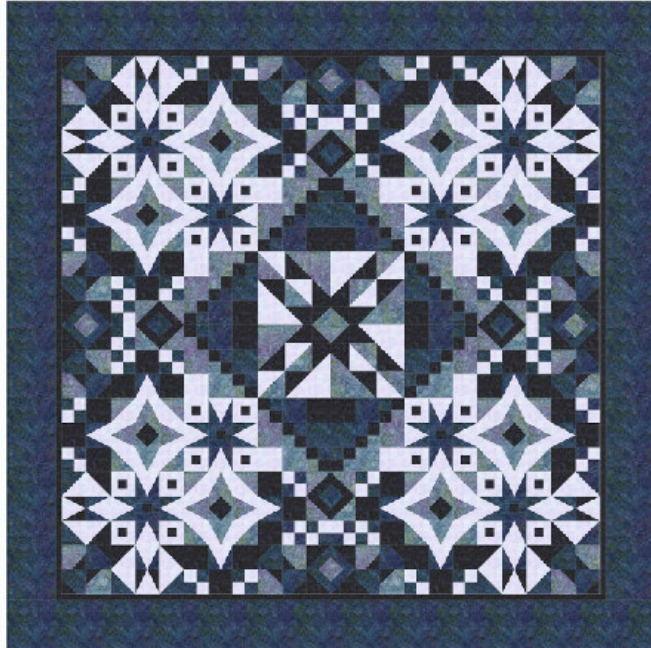

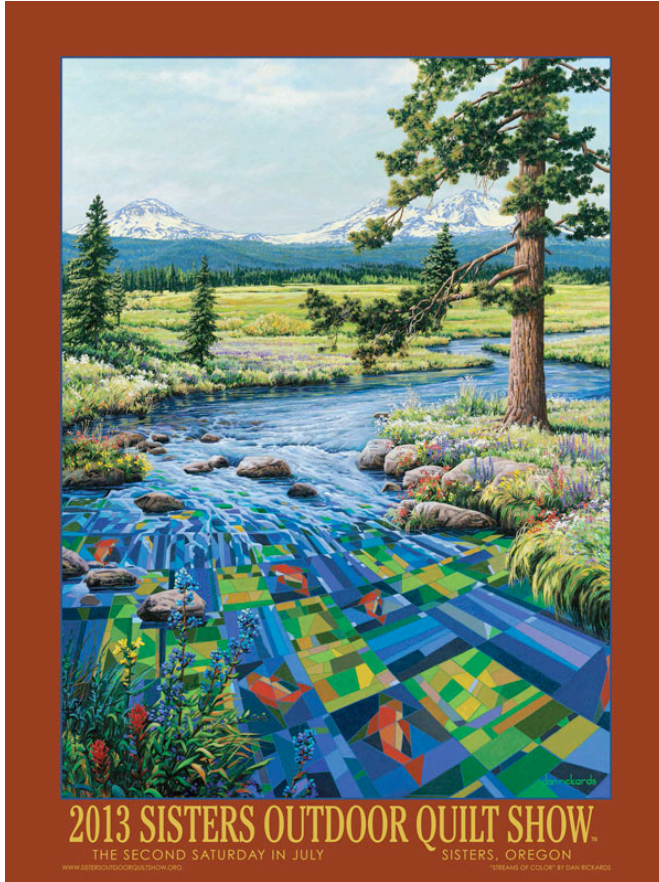
Asteria Block of the Month Greek Goddess of the Stars

Quilt is 106 x 106 and uses a handy tool, The Goddess Tool, for accurate cutting and piecing. Sign up in August 2013 with your pattern purchase of \$56.00 and all fabric for the complete quilt top for \$215.00. We will start the block of the month in September when the fabric arrives.

The quilt is a variety of stars made from gorgeous blue and white batiks. You'll be amazed as the combination of 4-patches, half-square triangle, and other simple blocks combine to form this masterpiece. As an extra bonus each month you'll receive a free quilt pattern featuring a new way to use your quilt block - that's a total of nine quilt patterns! The finished quilt measures 106" x 106". Quilt is designed for the advanced beginner quilter and beyond.

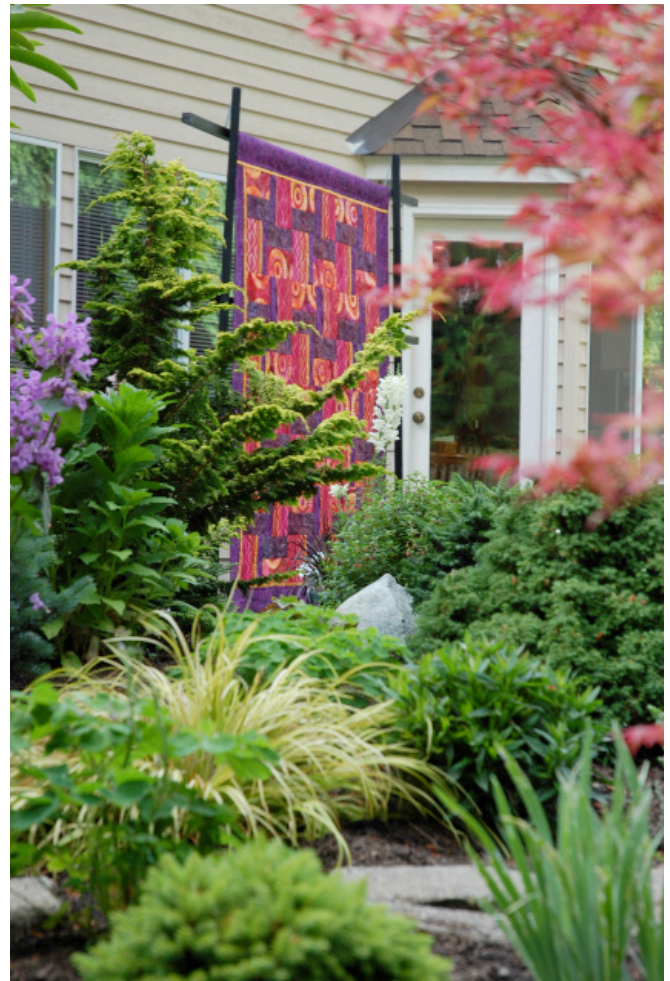
Mukilteo Garden & Quilt Tour

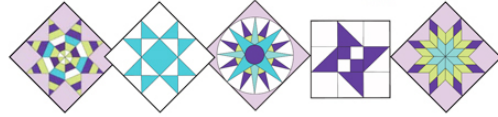
