


Red Crinoline Quilts
Fall Mystery Block of the Week 2016
Block 4/Week 4

These are the directions for block 4. We recommend that you print them for your own use. Please read through the entire instructions before beginning your block, referring to the color picture on page 2 as a guide for fabric placement.

Block 4

- A** Cut 2 (3 3/4") squares from a light print
- B** Cut 1 (1 3/4" x 7") rectangle from a light print
- C** Cut 2 (3 3/4") squares from a brown print
- D** Cut 1 (1 3/4" x 7") rectangle from a blue print
- E** Cut 1 (1 1/2") square from a light blue print



Constructing Block 4

With a pencil, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the light print **A** squares.

Place an **A** square and a brown print **C** square right sides together.

Sew 1/4" on either side of the pencil line. See diagram 1.

Cut on the pencil line. See diagram 2.

Press to the dark. See diagram 3.

Trim to 3" x 3".

Repeat for a total of 4 identical **A/C** half-square triangles.







Sew 1 light **B** rectangle and 1 blue **D** rectangle together. Press the seam to the dark

Cut apart every 1 1/2" for a total of 4 sub-cut bar units. See diagram 4.




Sew 4 **A/C** half-square triangles, 4 bar units and 1 light blue **E** square together into 3 rows.

Press as indicated by arrows. Sew the rows together.

See diagram 5.



Press seams to row 2.


