Fabric supply list:

- 2 yards background fabric: tone on tone or cream or white
- 1/2 yard inner borders with small print or tone on tone (black, red, green or blue)
- 1 yard borders Christmas print
- 1/2 yard binding (match inner or outer border fabric)
- 1 1/4 yard backing
- 3 yards woven interfacing (like Shape Flex by Pellon SF101)

Embroidery supply list:

- Medium weight tear away
- 505 temporary adhesive spray
- Removable fabric marker
- Basic embroidery kit including small doubled curved scissors, long straight pointy tweezers, etc.
- Embroidery needles 80/12 and 90/14
- 40 wt embroidery thread (Isacord #'s listed)
 - 0020 black
 - 1094 berries
 - 2520 pink present
 - 1342 brown for gingerbread
 - 3901 blue for candy, stockings and present
 - 2900 dark purple for ornaments, bow and candy
 - 0704 gold for ribbon
 - 5722 green for sprigs
 - 5730 lighter green for holly leaves
 - 5833 darker green for holly leaves
- USB stick for transferring designs to sewing machine

- Embroidery module
