Piecing Directions

Block 1

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each Fabric A square measuring 3 7/8" x 3 7/8". Match 26 of the squares together with 26 squares of the same size cut from fabric B. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each remaining Fabric B square measuring 3 7/8" x 3 7/8". Match 52 of the squares together with 52 squares of the same size cut from fabric C.
- 2. Follow the directions for making half-square triangles on page 2. You will have 156 half-square triangles when this step is completed. 52 will be with fabrics A and B, 104 will be with fabrics B and C.
- 3. Following the diagram below, sew four squares together to form a block. All of the blocks are made exactly this same way. Continue with the remaining squares until you have 52 completed blocks.

4. Following the diagram below, take four of the completed blocks in the previous step and sew them together in the exact order shown. This will make a larger block. There will be 13 of these larger blocks in the quilt. Continue with the remaining smaller blocks until you have 13 completed larger blocks.
